## Chadderton South Ward: An Introduction

Chadderton South Ward consists of various communities including large residential areas such as the Long Lane and areas of disadvantage such as Coalshaw Green area. More recently, the more affluent area of Foxdenton Lane and the new development at Foxdenton Farm which is houses and industrial units.

The newly built Rose Street Housing estate comprises of family homes, with South Chadderton Metrolink stop just behind the site as well as easy access to main roads including the M60.

In this community there is a new economy emerging with an African theme (shops on Coalshaw Green Road), and two growing community groups SAWN and All Sufficient Sanctuary who are supporting African families and families with no recourse to public funds, suggesting the community dynamics are changing. There has also been a recent large immigration of Hong Kong Chinese, who reside in the new housing around Cavalier Square area off Lydia Becker Way.

The main M60 motorway junction is situated here. One of the main arterial roads (Broadway) runs through this area and other districts and then on into Manchester. Foxdenton Lane is also a main road and runs from Broadway, via Lydia Becker way, to Middleton Junction. Buses run down Broadway to its end at the A62 in Failsworth the into Manchester from Oldham. There is a local tram stop (South Chadderton) in the vicinity.

There is a secondary school in the ward; Blessed John Henry Newman RC, and primary schools White gate End, Corpus Christi, Stanley Road Yewtree.

In terms of shops, there is a Costco, Lidl, and a parade of shops at Butler Green.

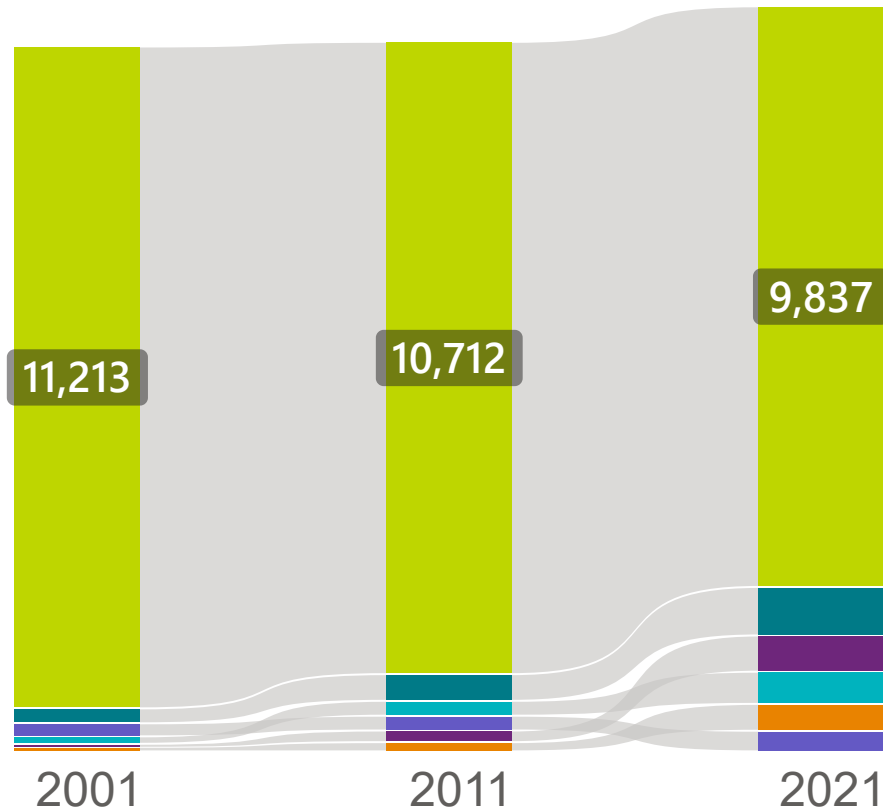

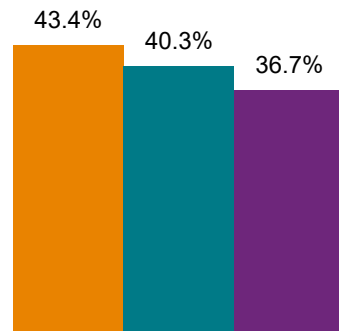

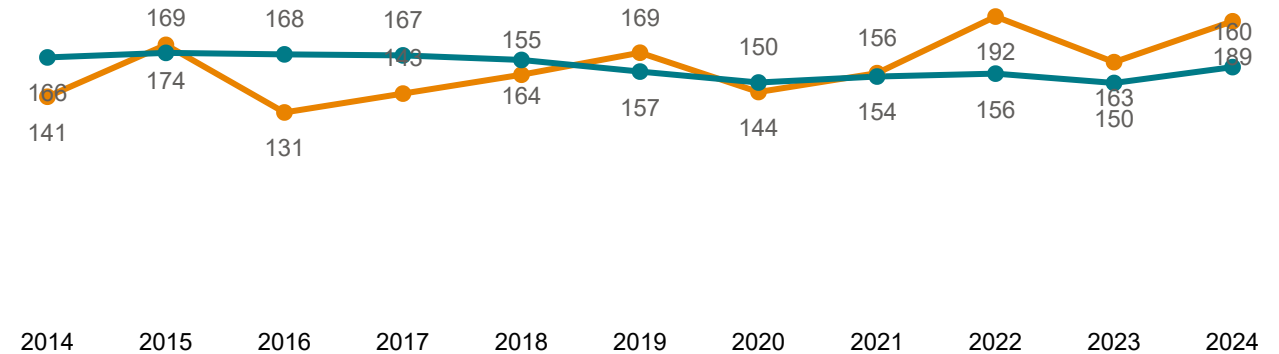

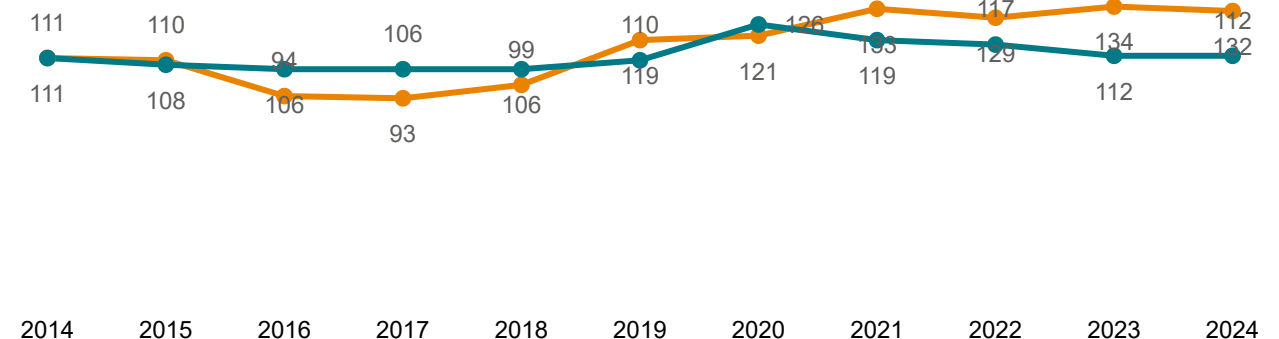

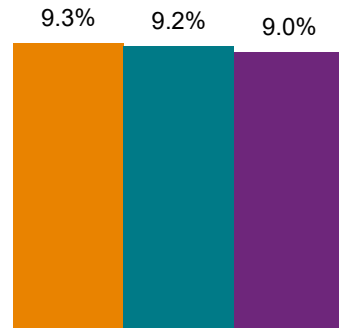

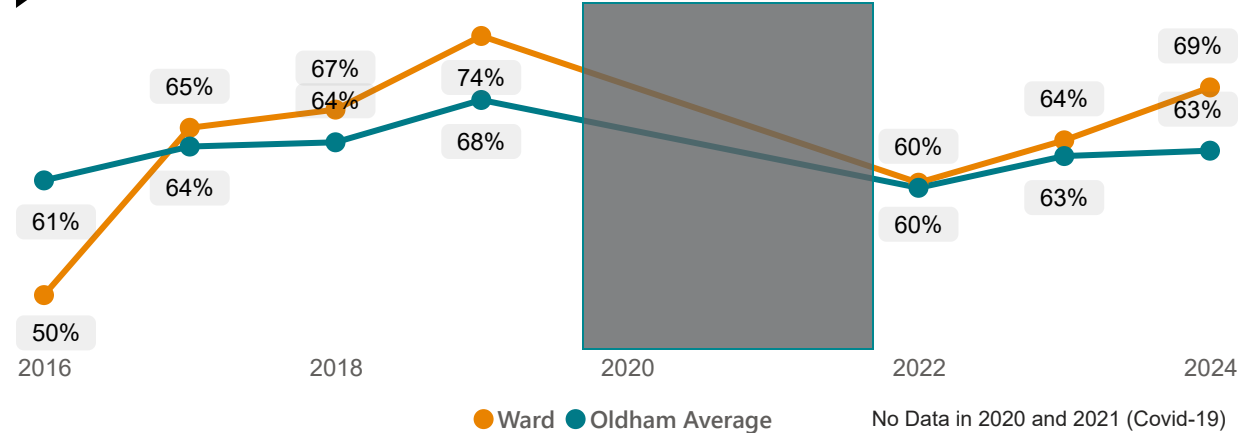

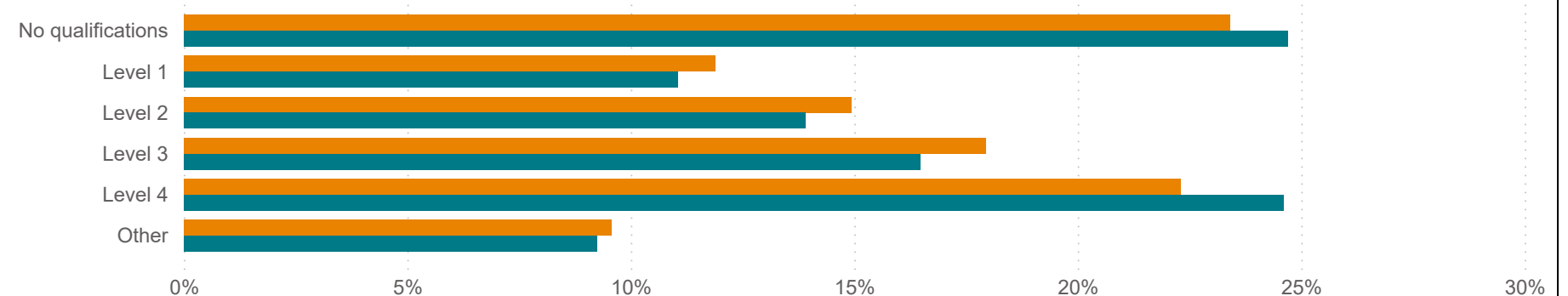

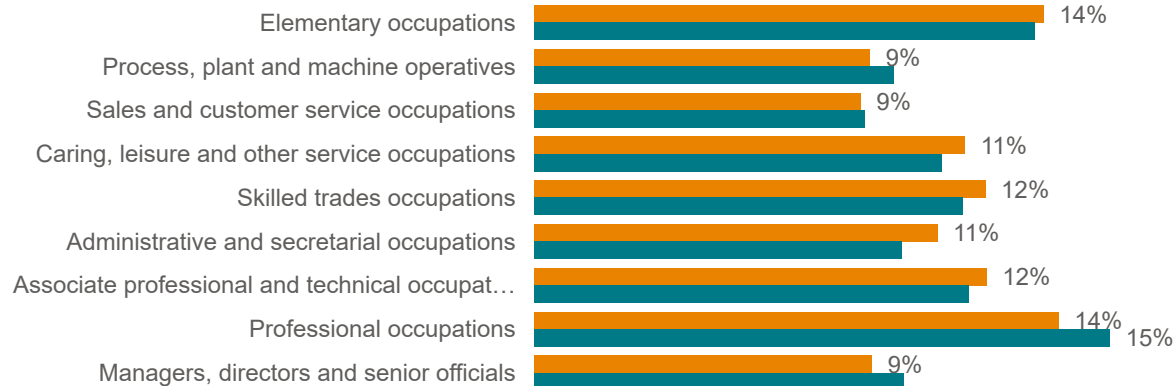

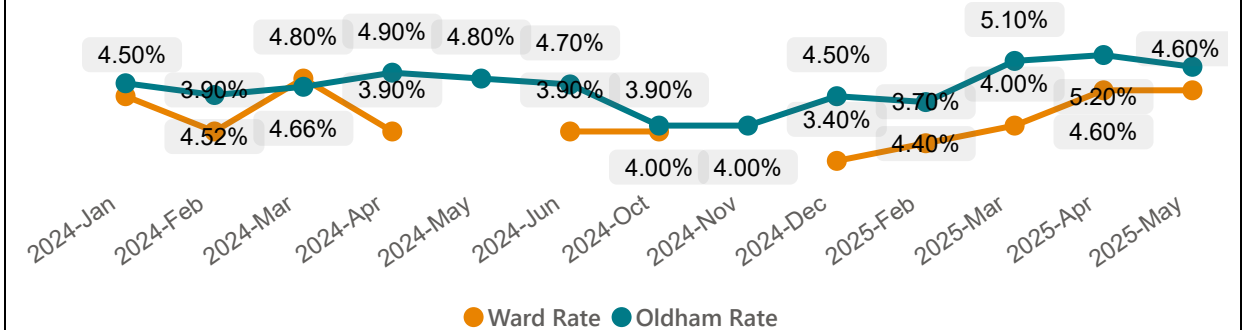

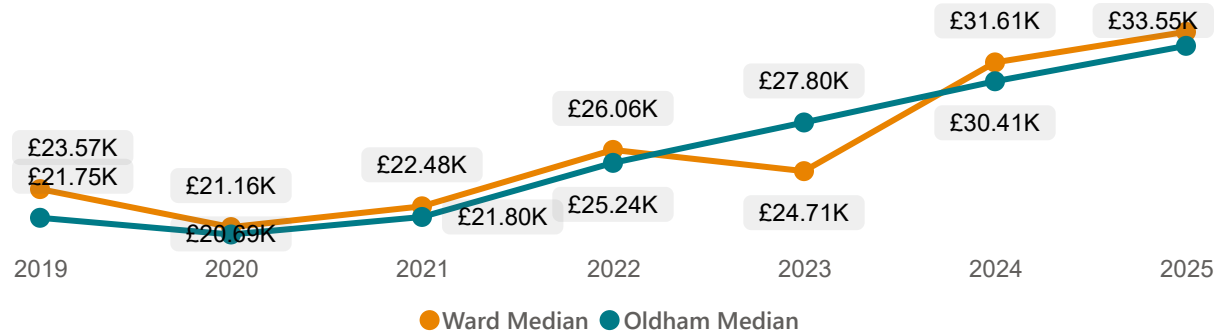

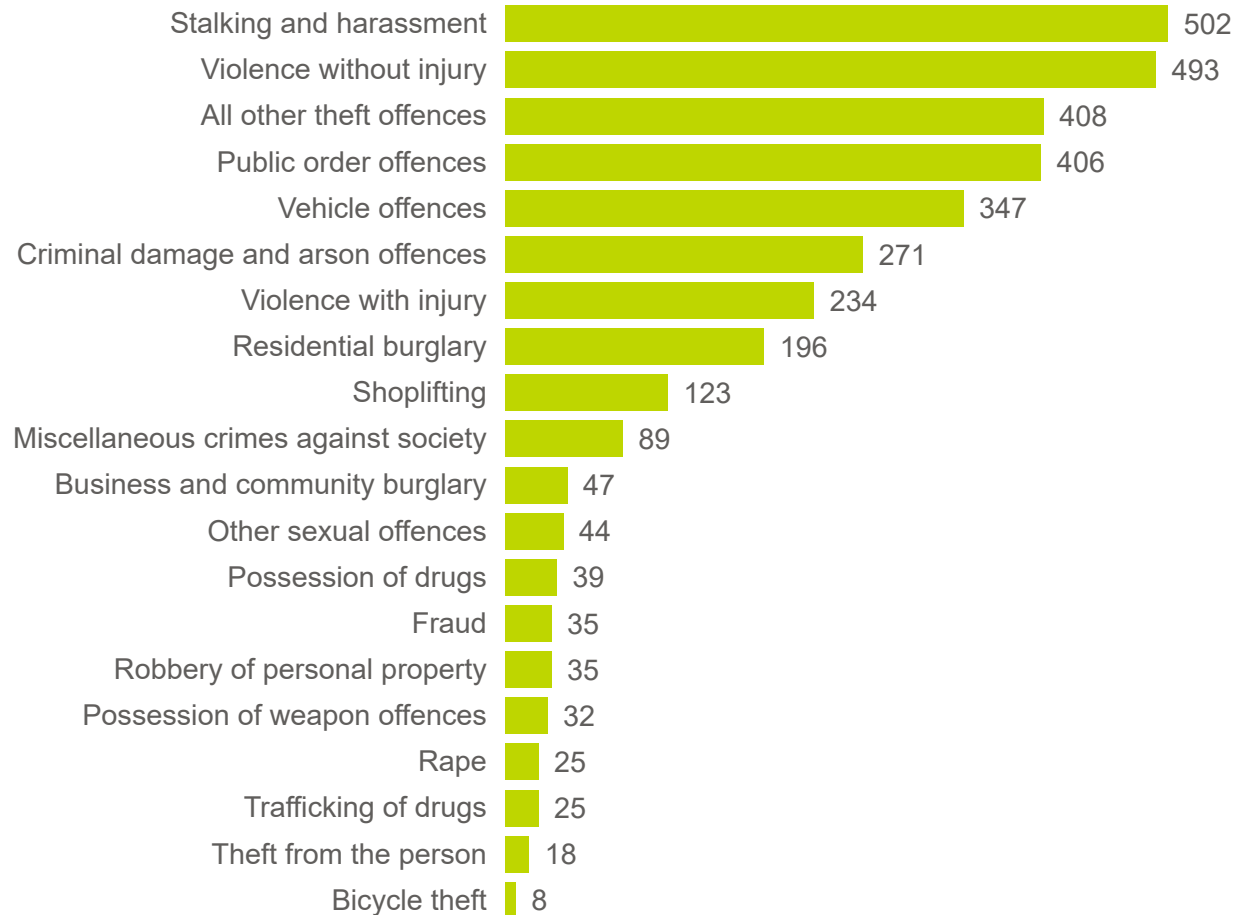

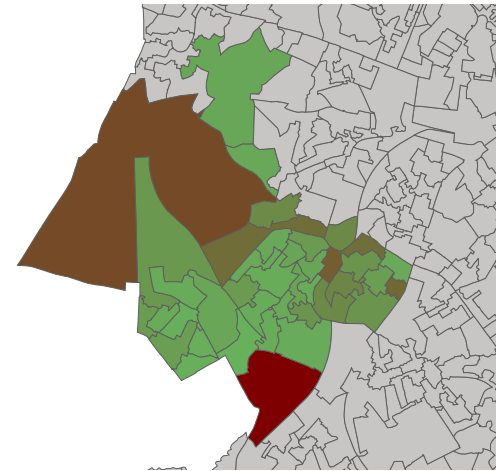

## Reported Crimes 2021-23 by Category



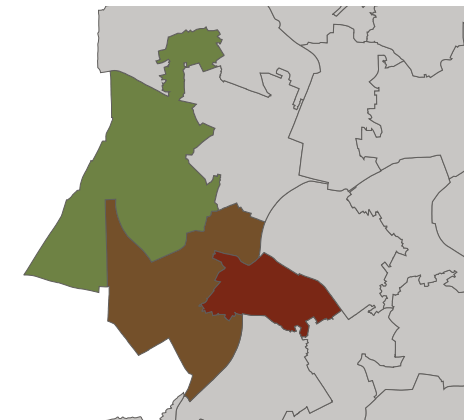

## Trust Map Information

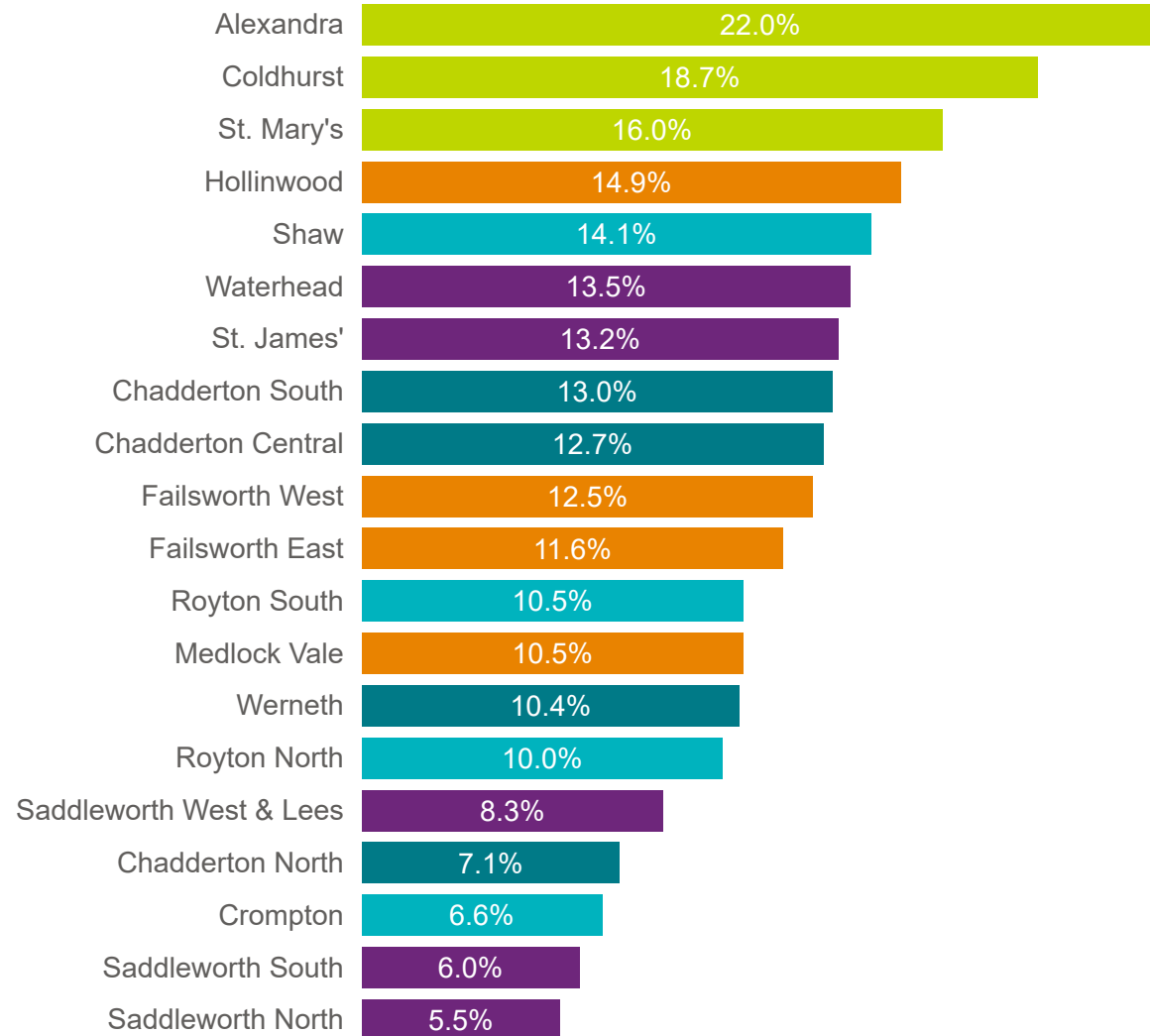

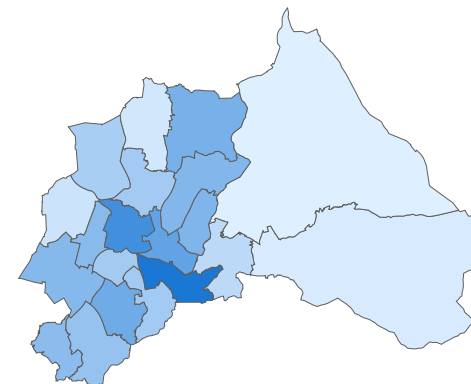

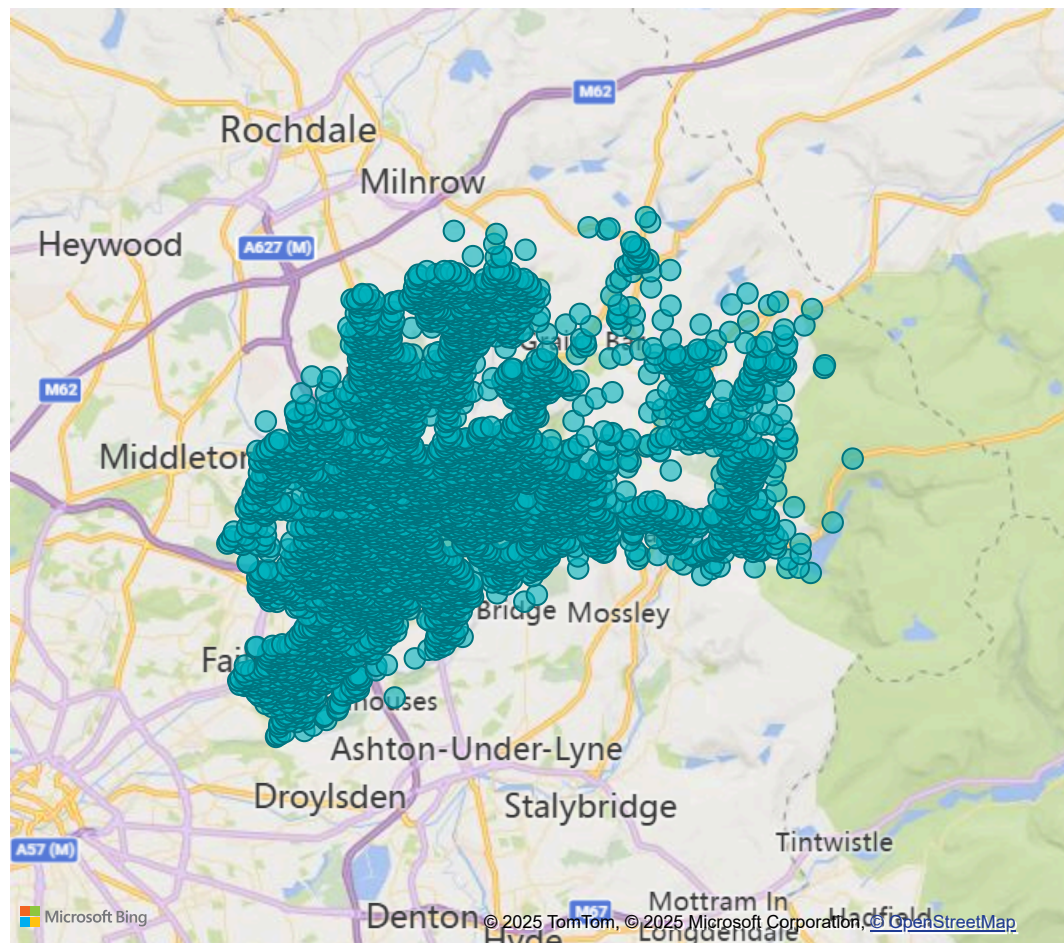
