Coldhurst

Coldhurst has the largest population with 15,210 residents. The population increased by 15% between 2011 and 2021.

58% of residents are Bangladeshi, the largest proportion of any ward in Oldham.

Lowest GLD results in the borough (45%), Attainment 8 (GCSE) score is greater than the Oldham average.

Lowest median household income in the borough.

26% of households overcrowded, the second highest rate in the borough.

Highest rate of obesity in Year 6 in the borough (48%).

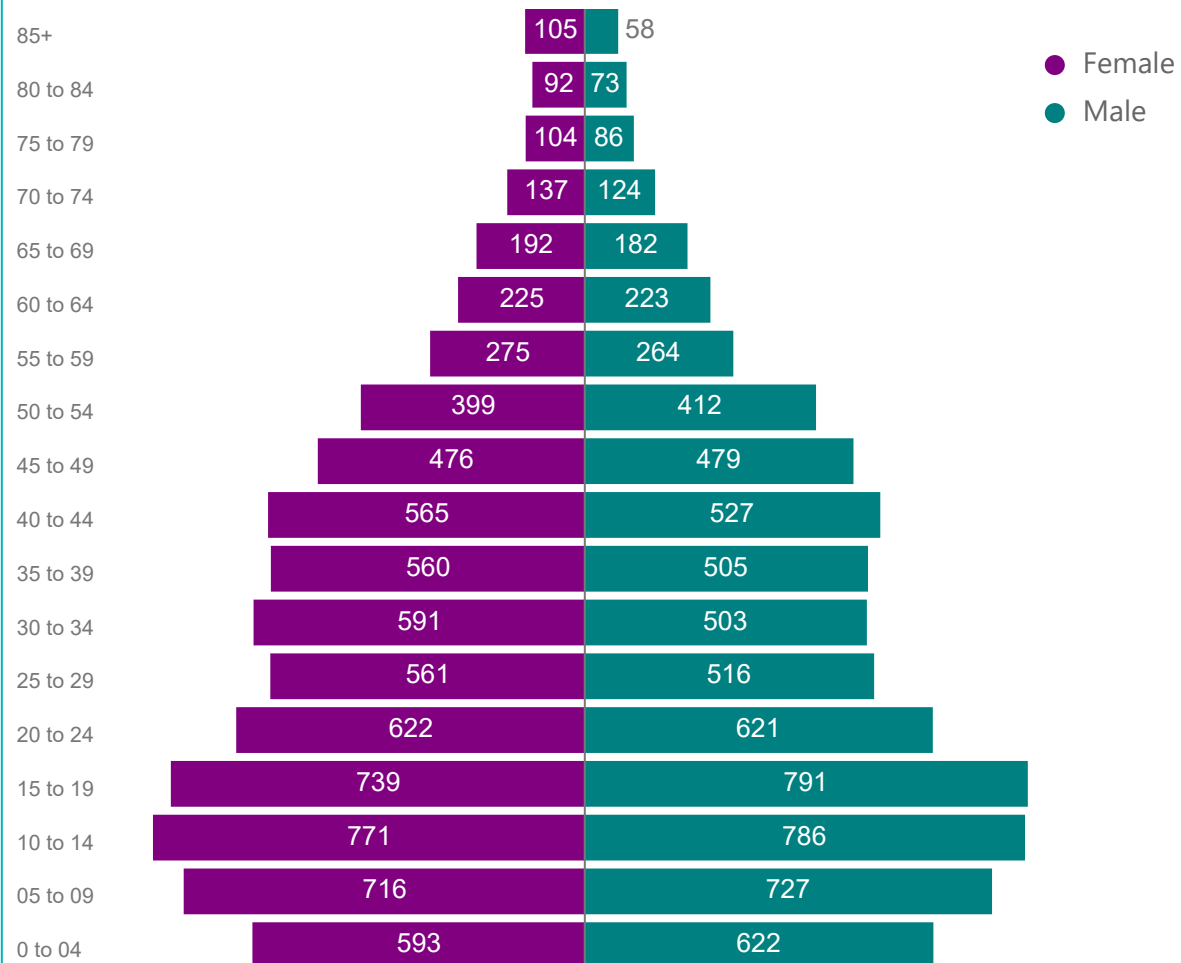

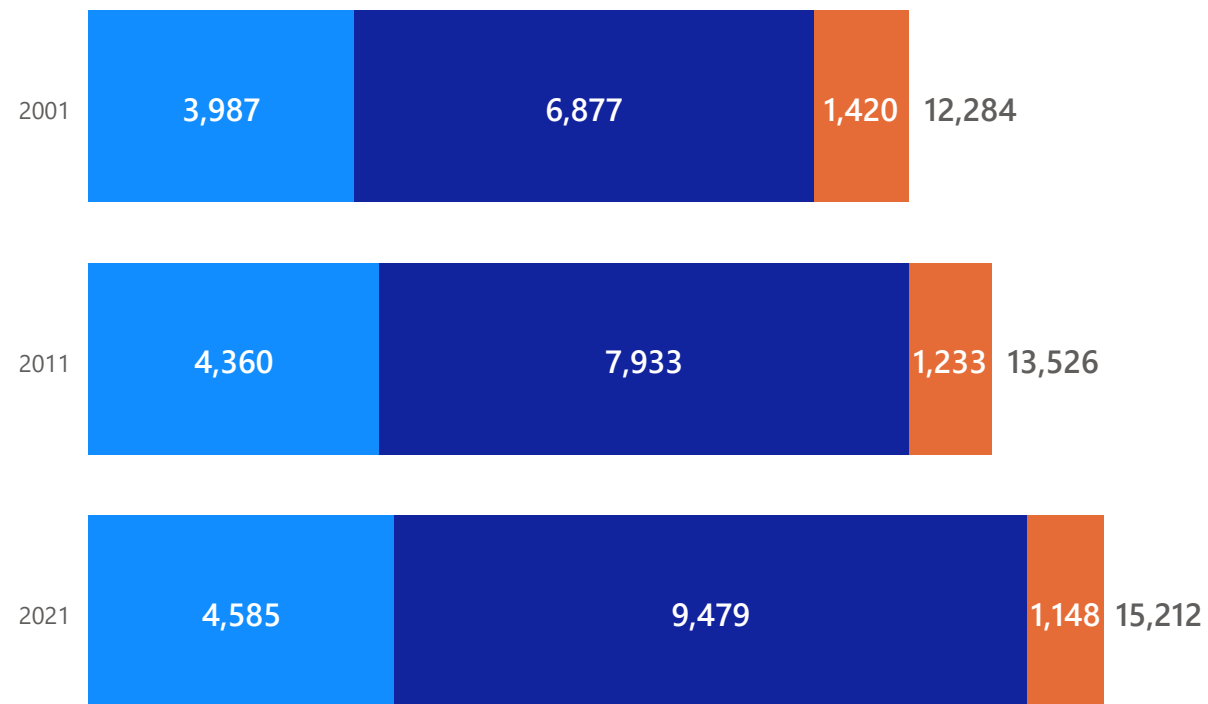

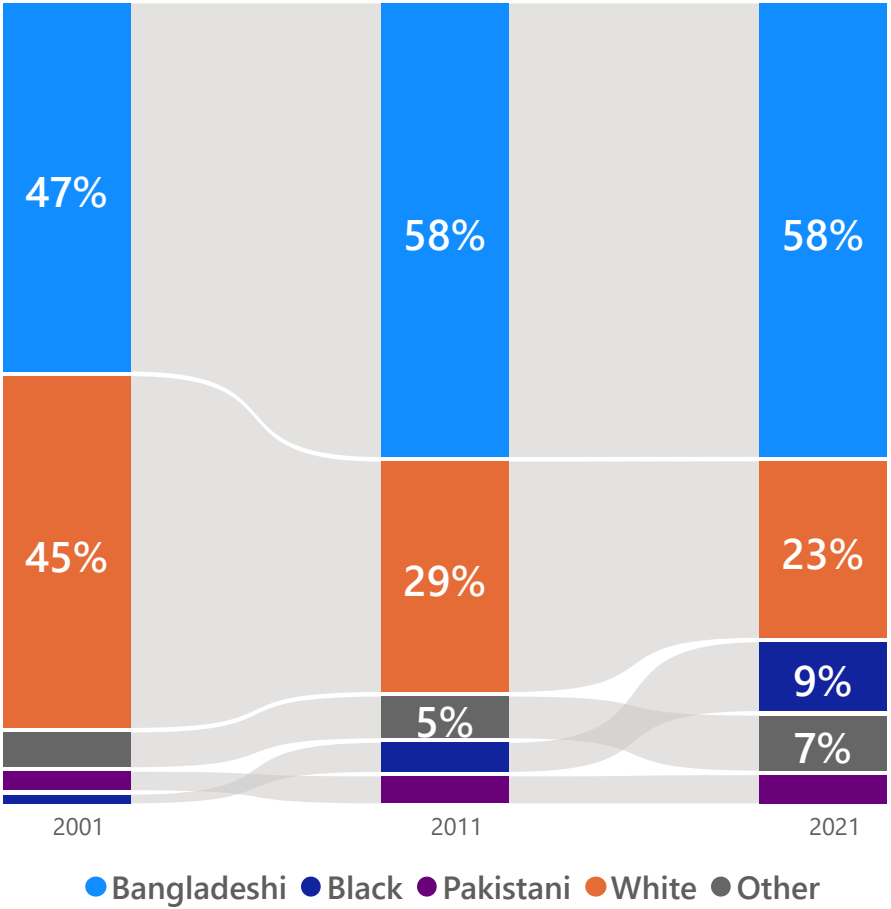

Ethnicity by Year (Percentage)



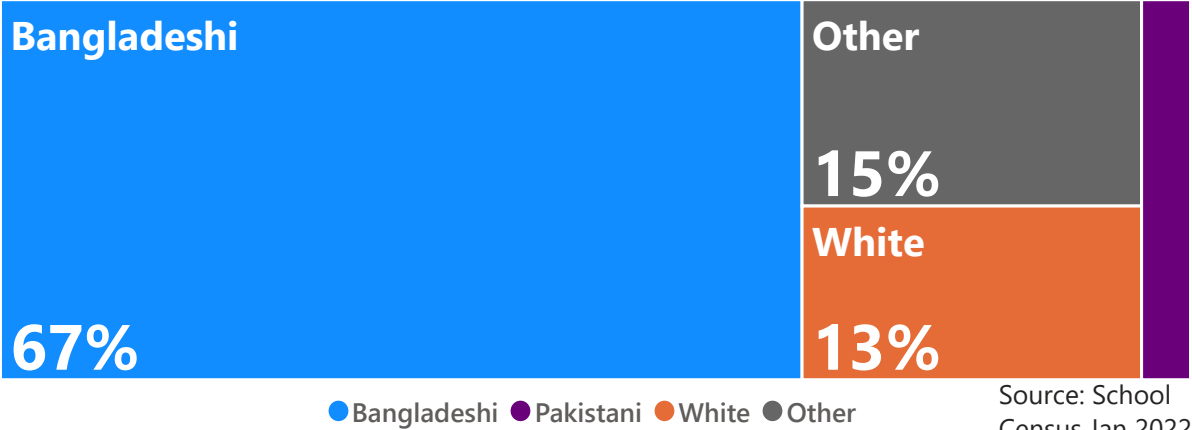

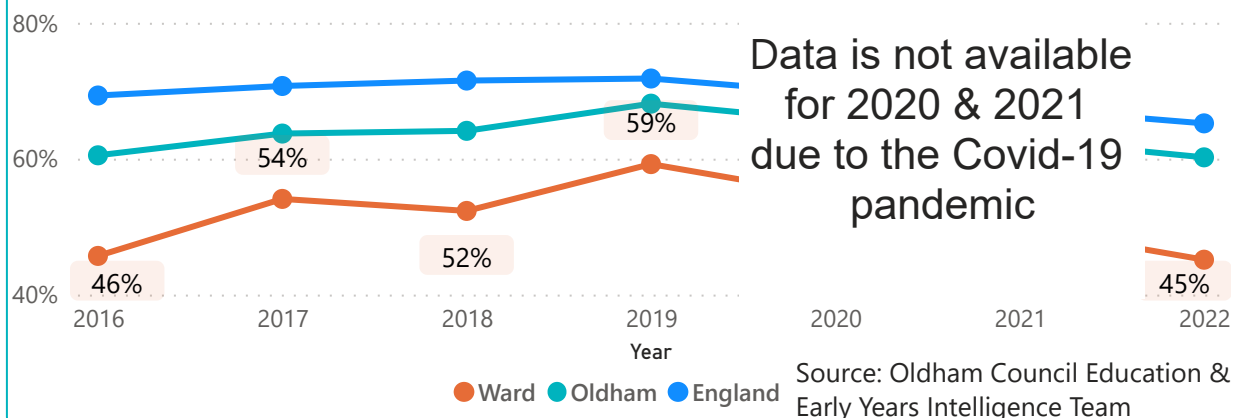

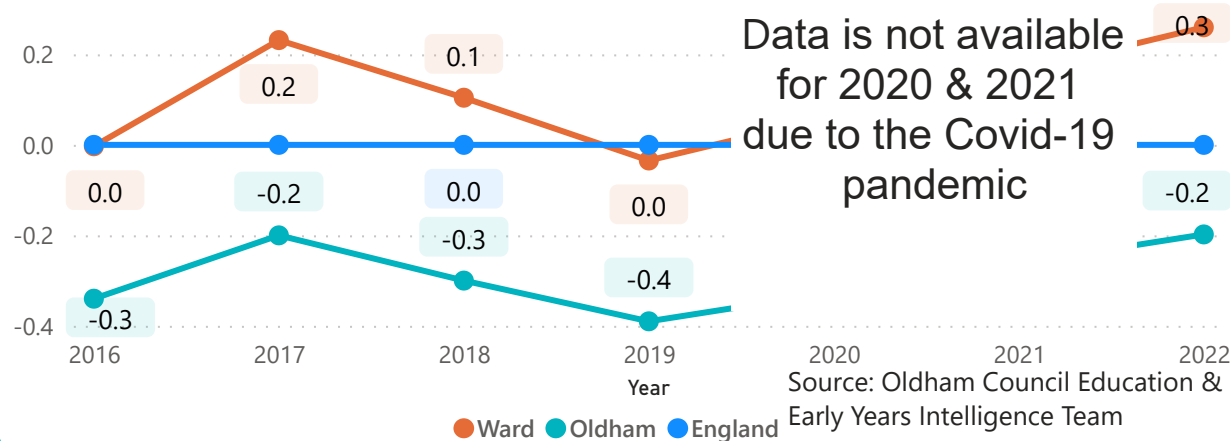

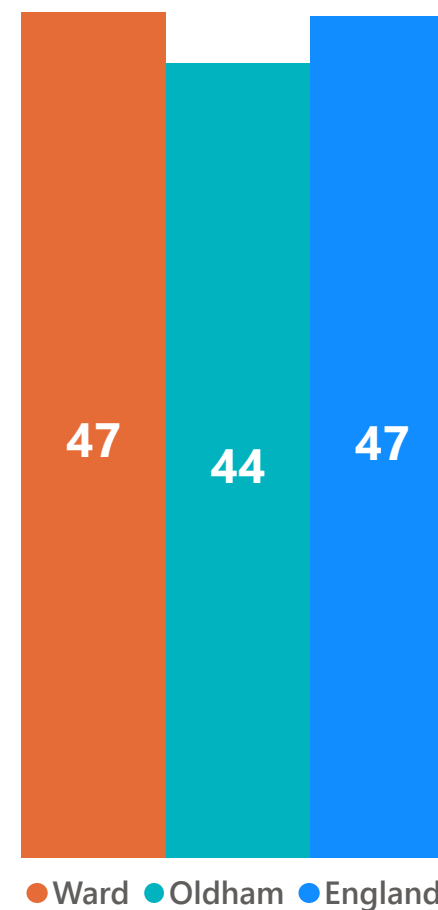
Children achieving a good level of development by the end of reception

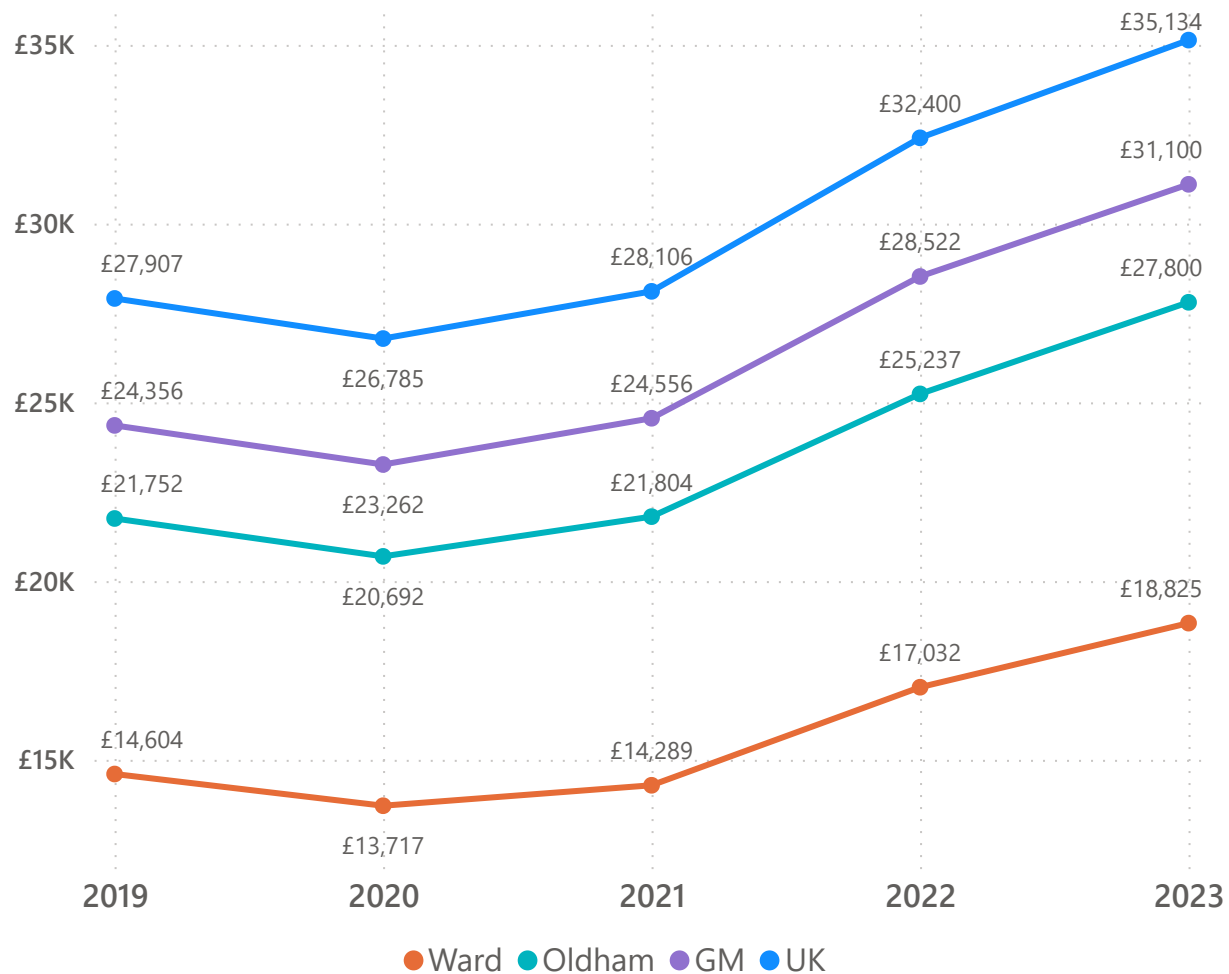

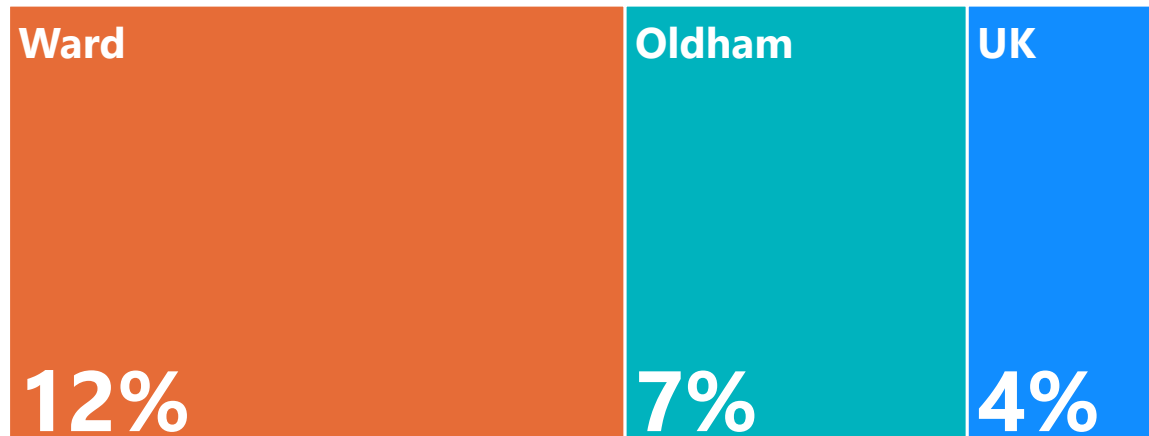

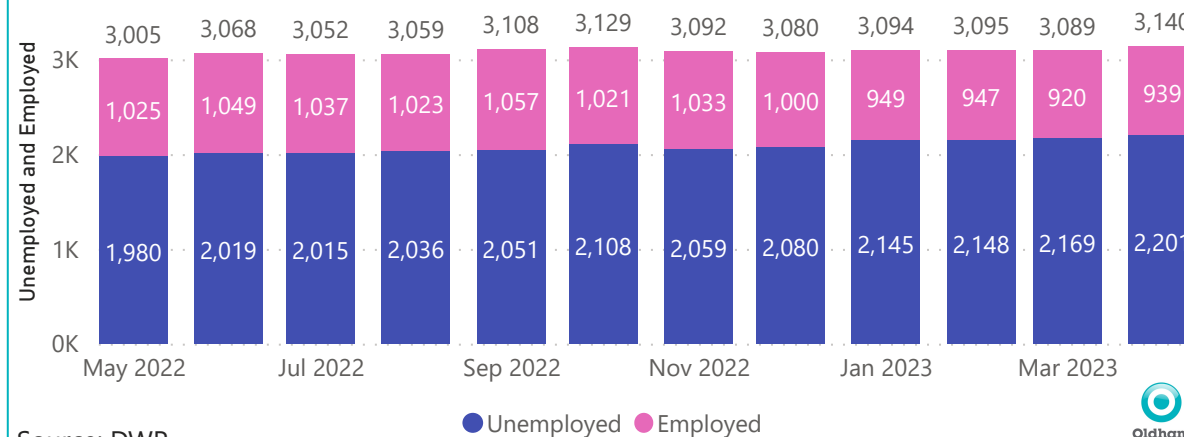

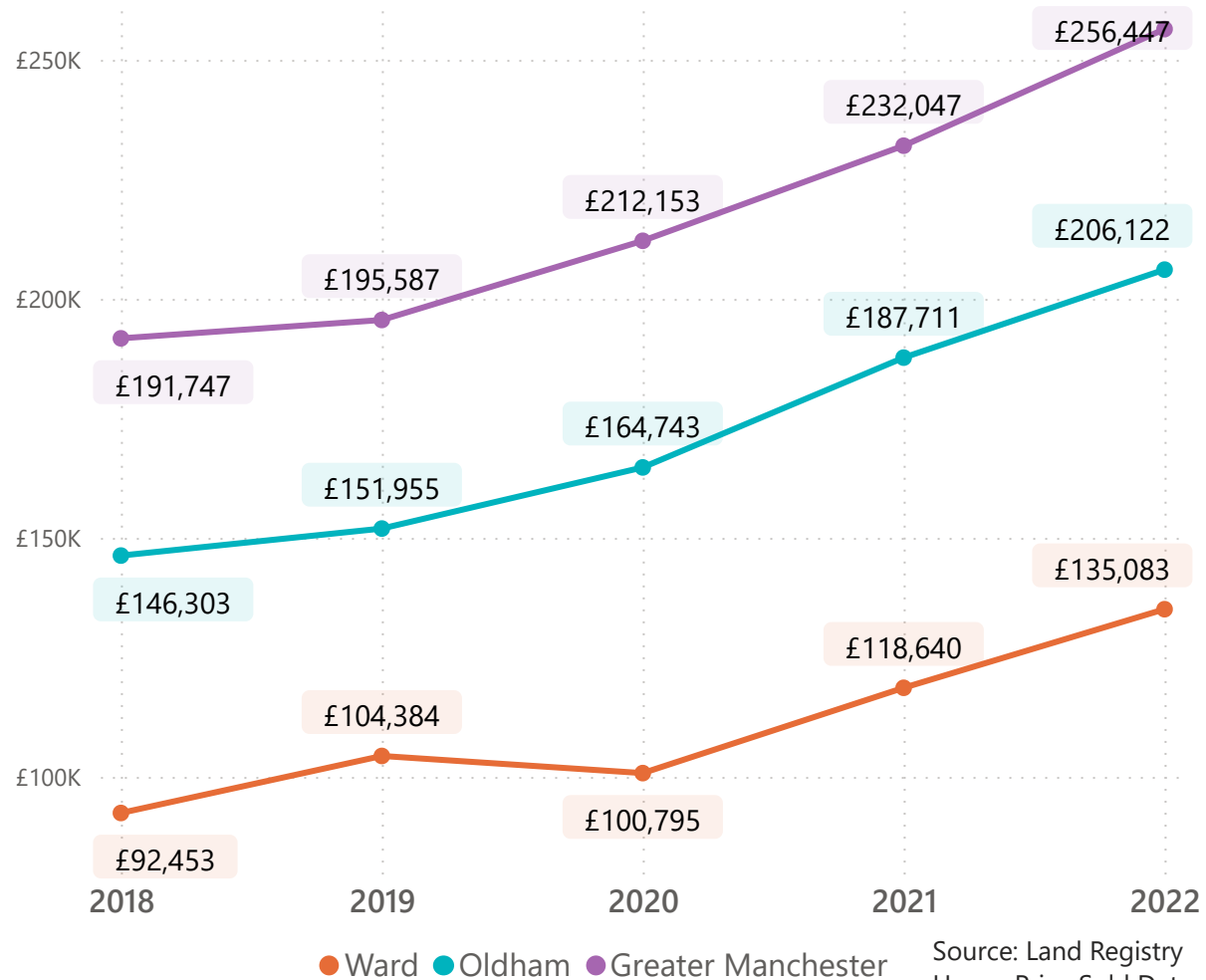

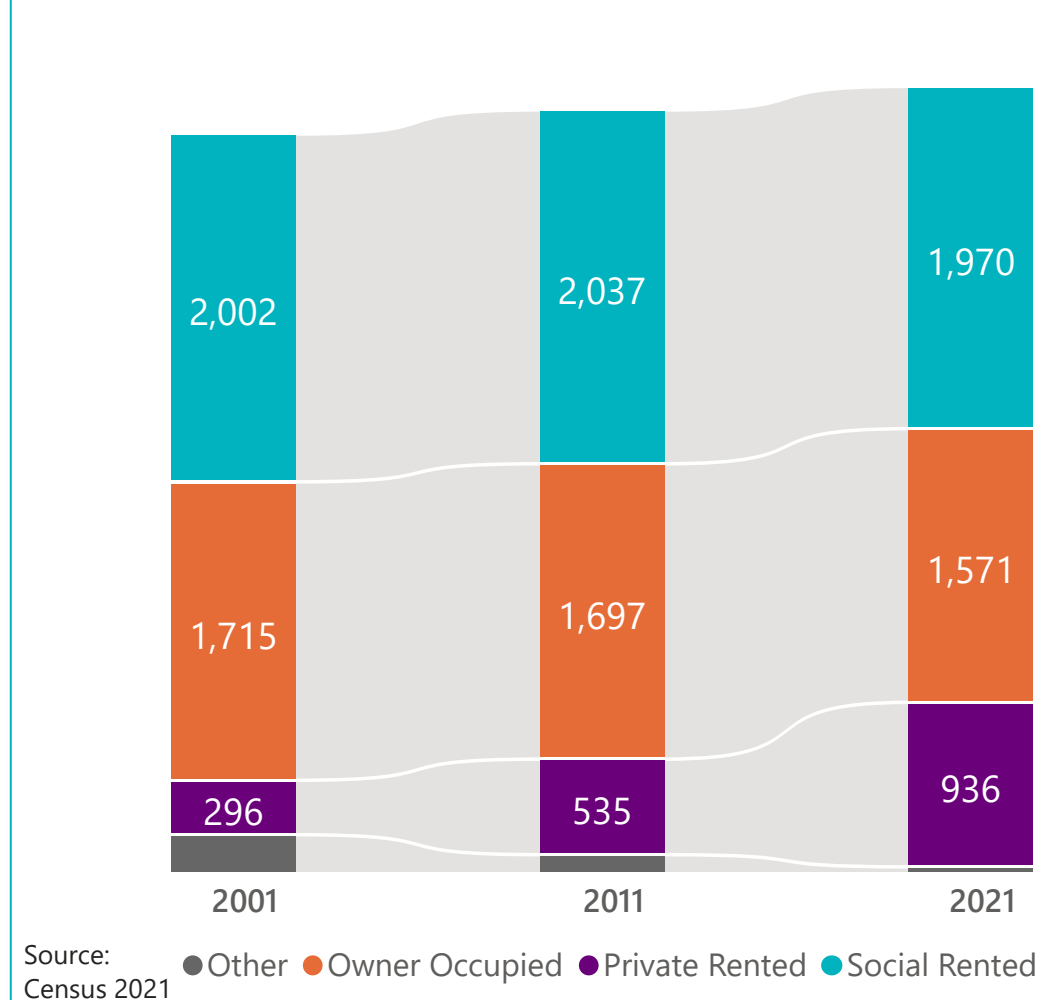

Housing Tenure by Year



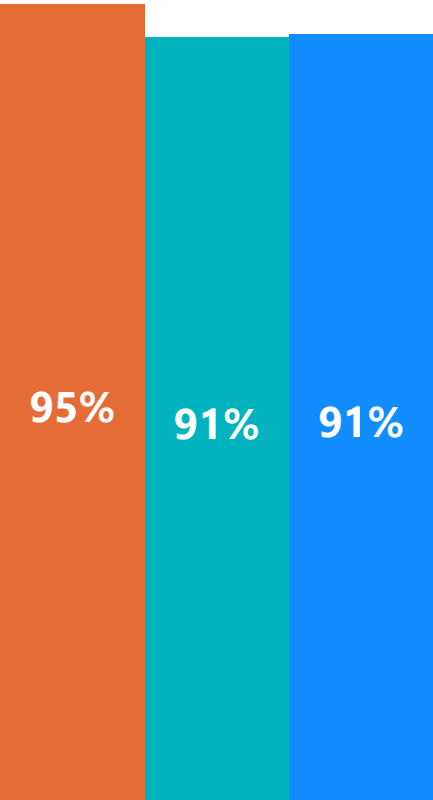

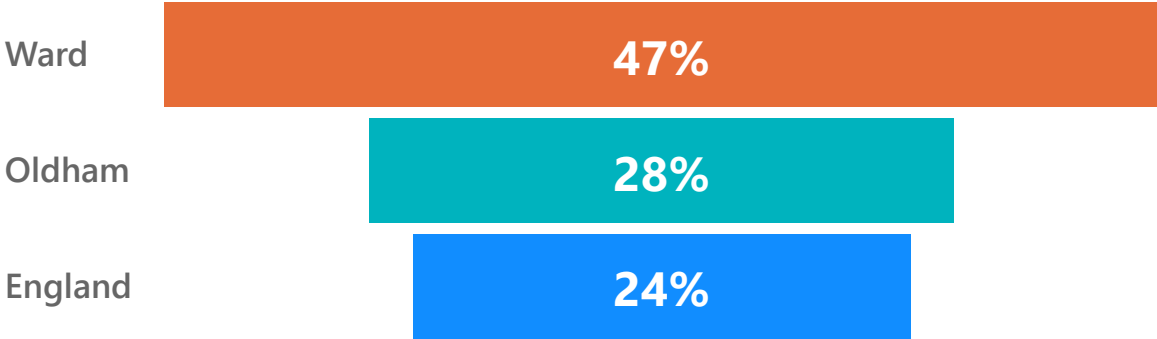
Adult Population Registered to Vote

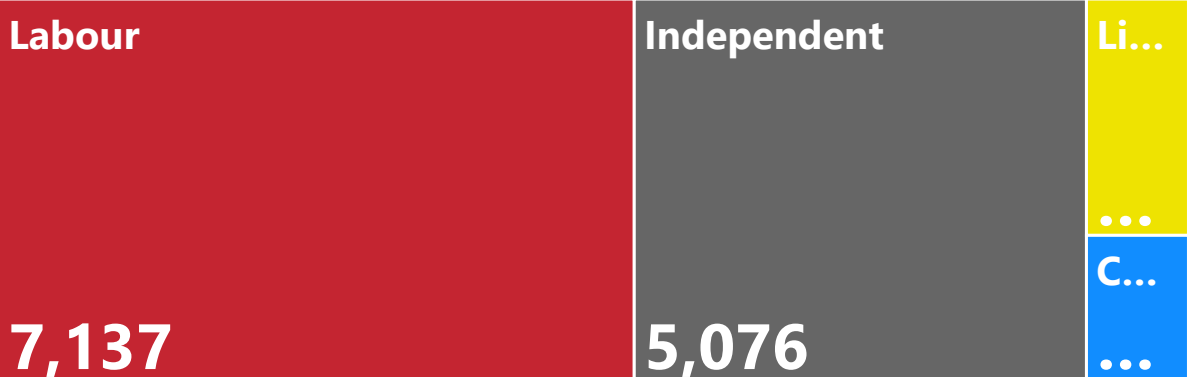
Households with No Car or Van

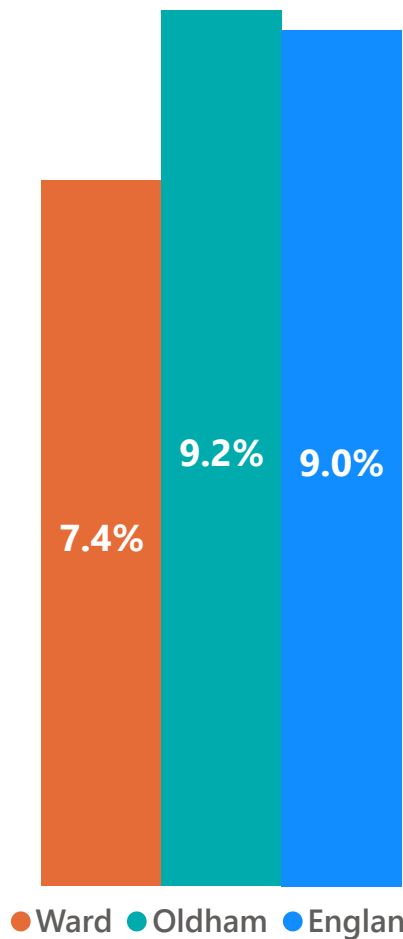

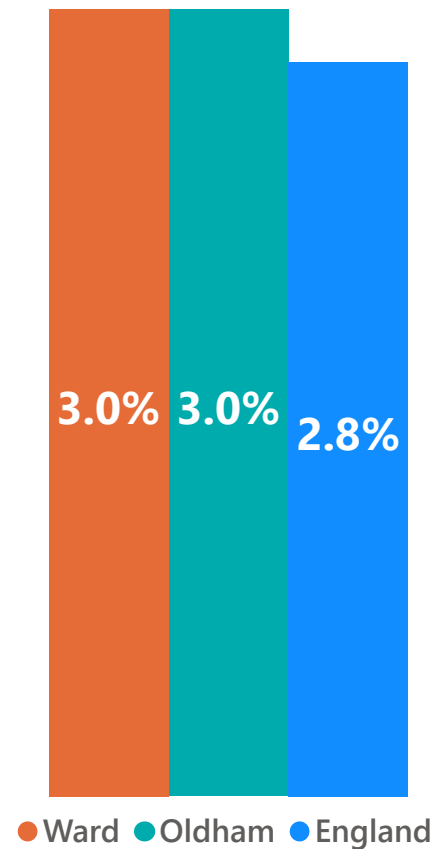

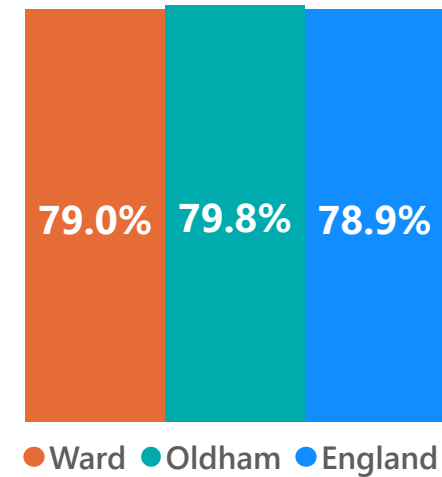

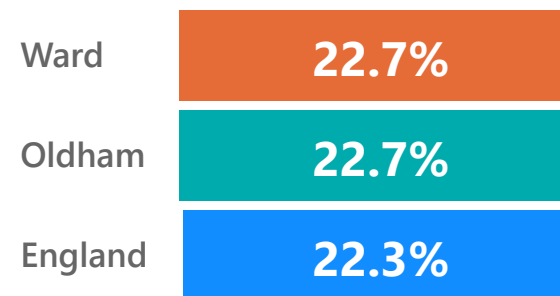


General Health 'Good' or 'Very Good'

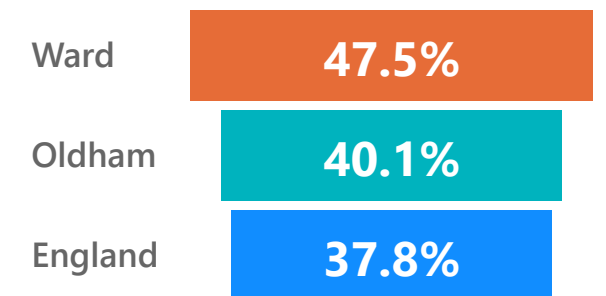
