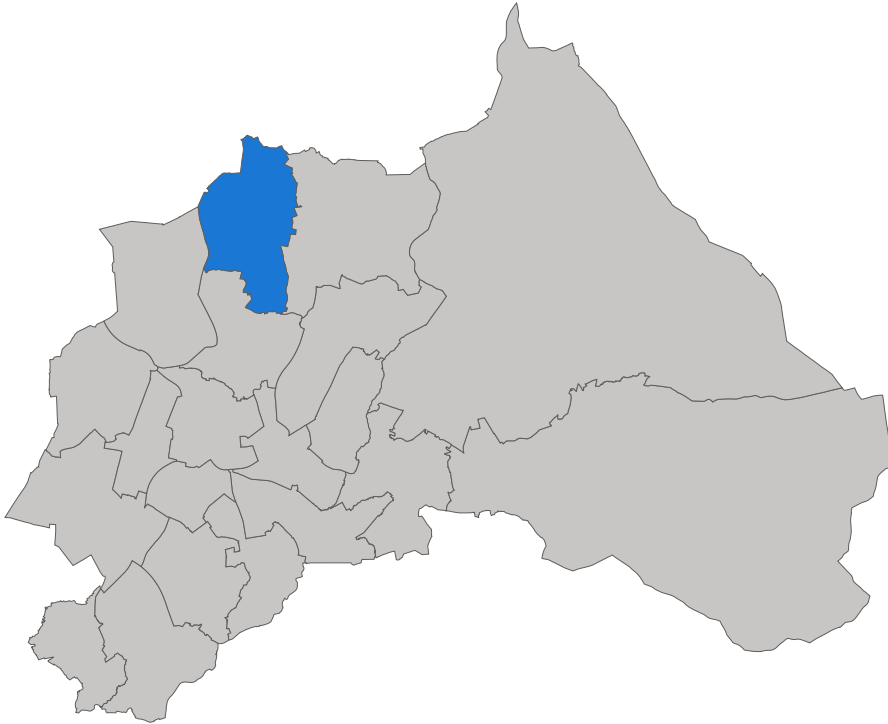

Crompton Ward: An Introduction

The Crompton ward is the most north westerly ward in the borough and shares a border with Rochdale. A large part of the ward is semi-rural, with a large number of farms and greenspaces. High Crompton Park is a popular and well used community facility with an active bowling community and the ward also has well used playing fields at New Barn, although the changing rooms are sadly no longer in use.

The ward has a high proportion of well maintained, owner occupied housing with relatively low levels of social housing and private rented accommodation.

Crompton ward has an ageing population with 23.4% being aged over 65, compared to the borough average of 15.6%, with above average life expectancy rates, especially for women. The ageing population presents a challenge to the community, including ensuring the community is accessible and inclusive.

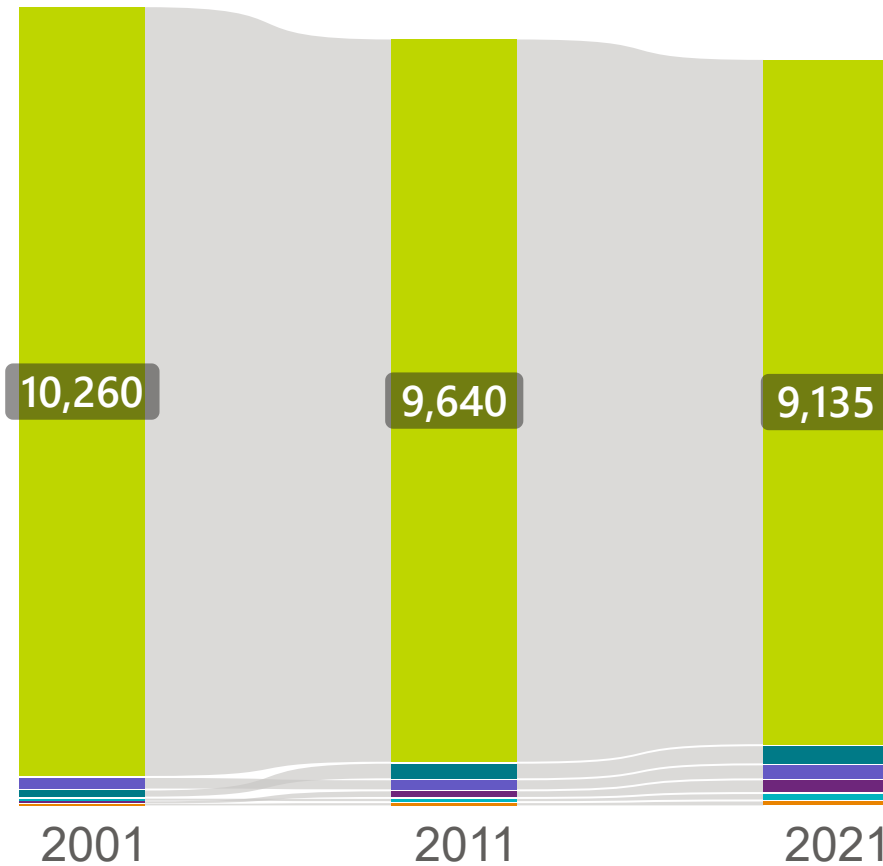

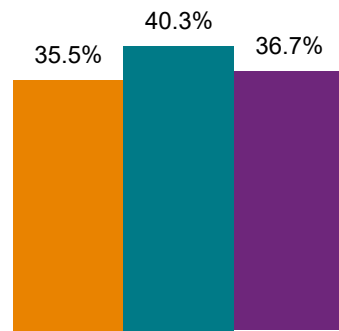

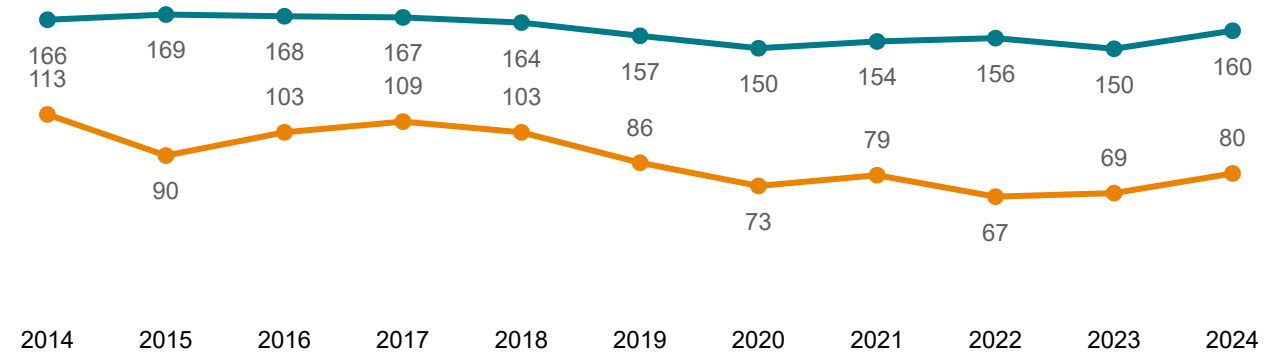

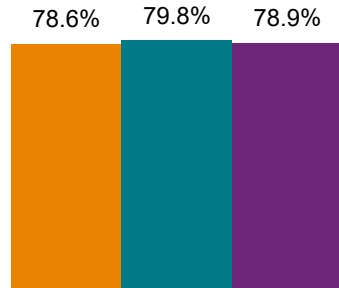
Number of Births by Year

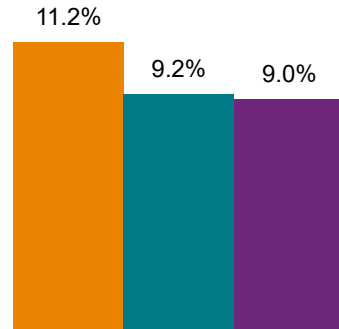

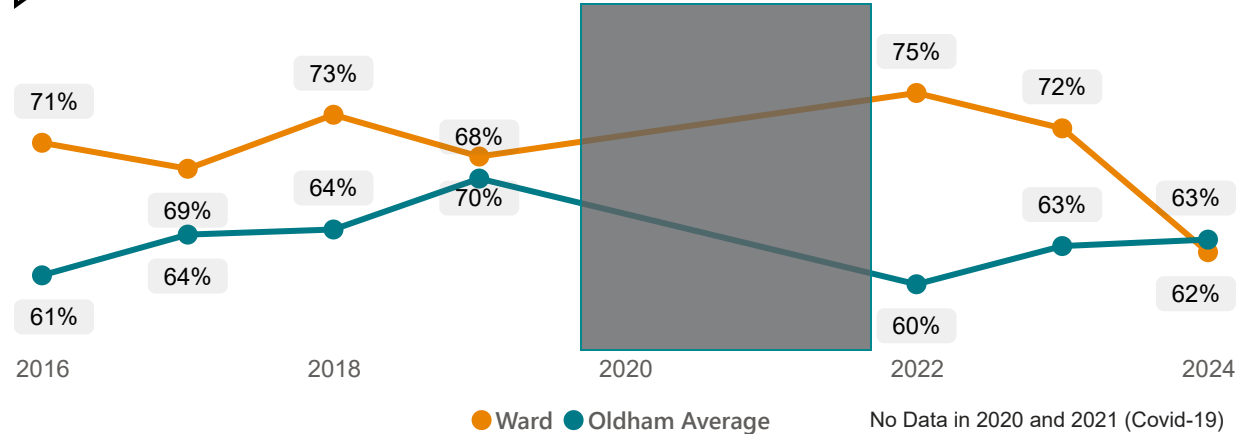

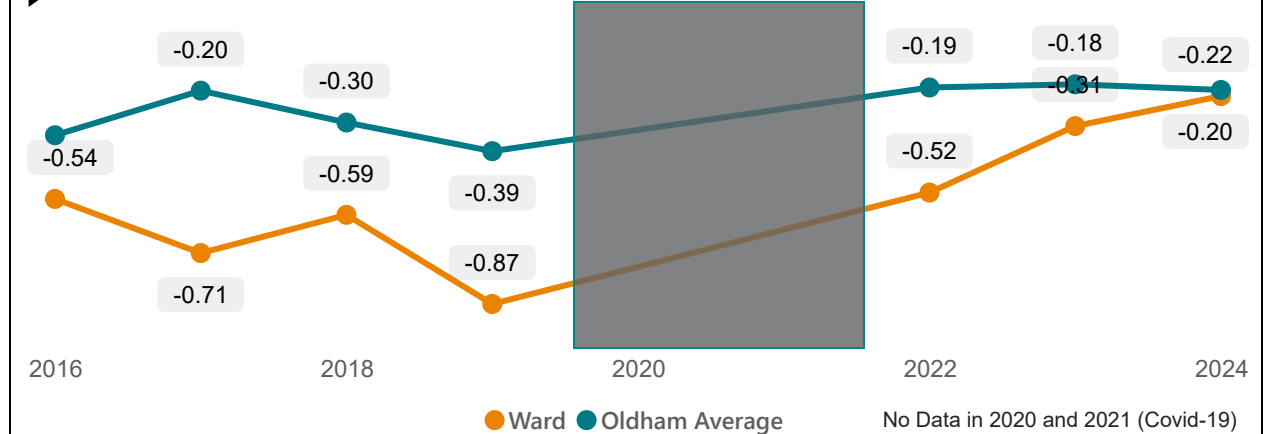

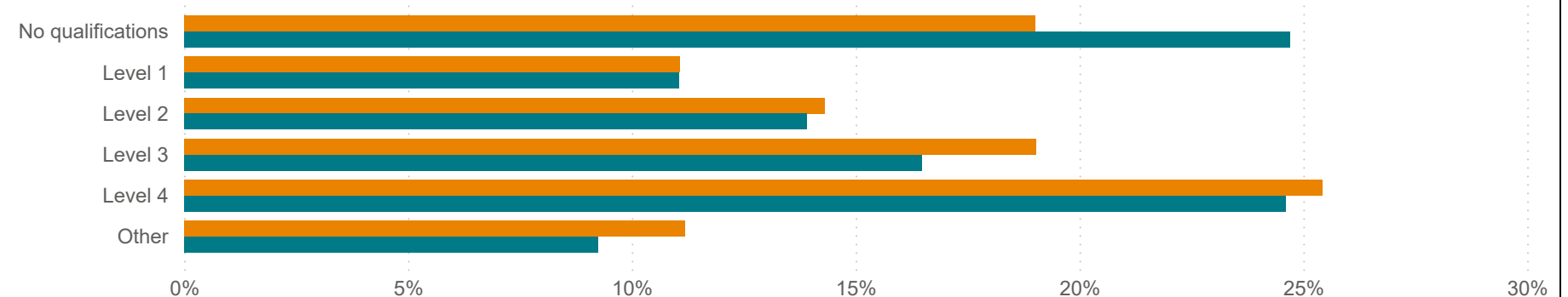

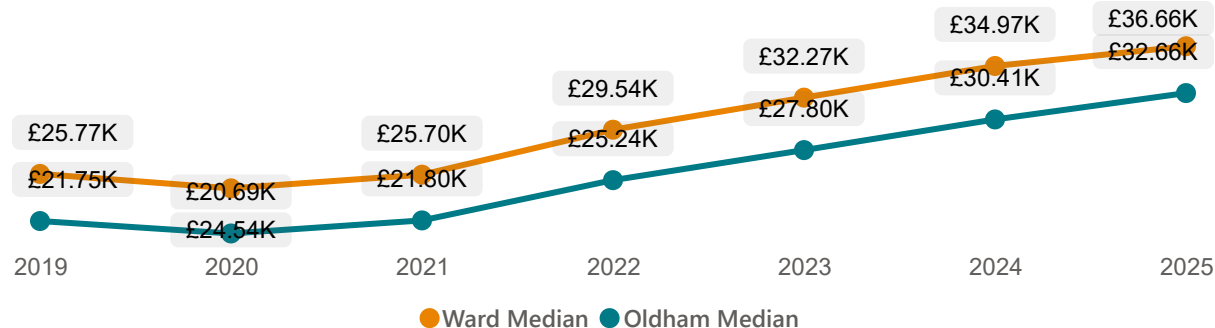

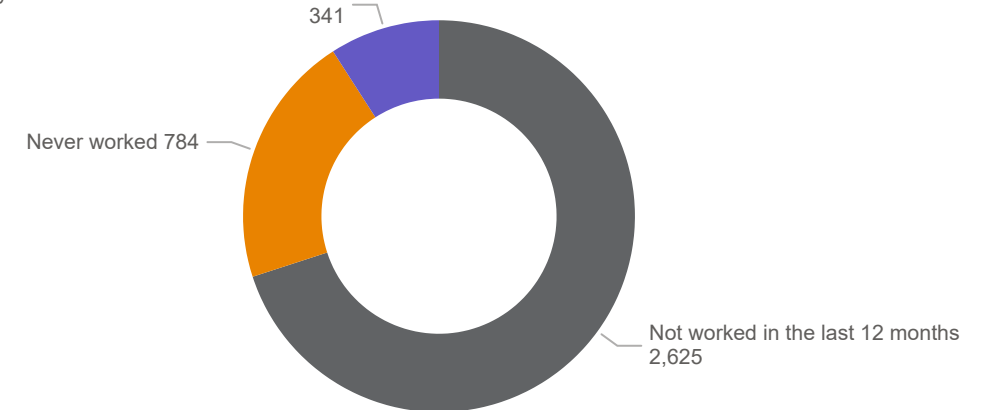


Median Equivalised Household Income

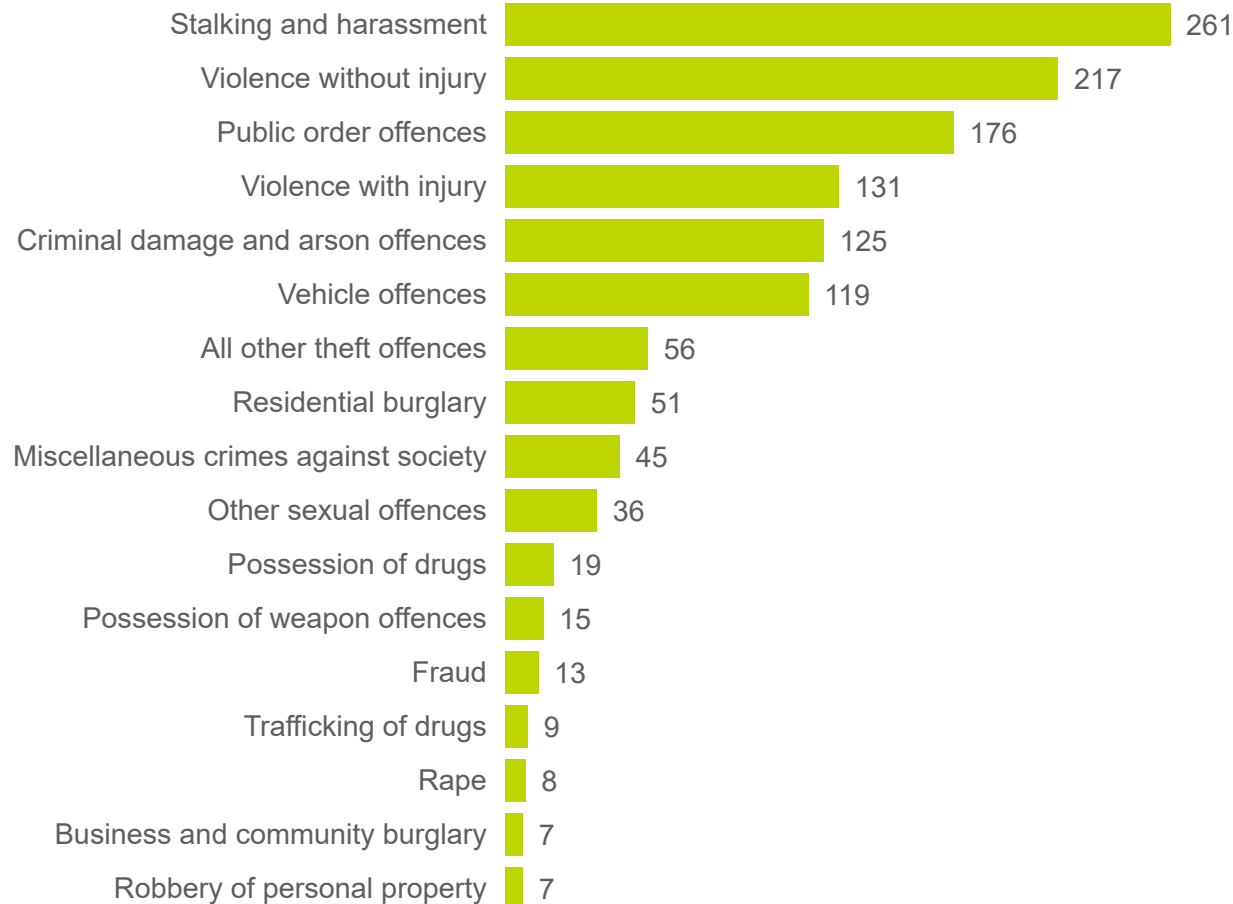

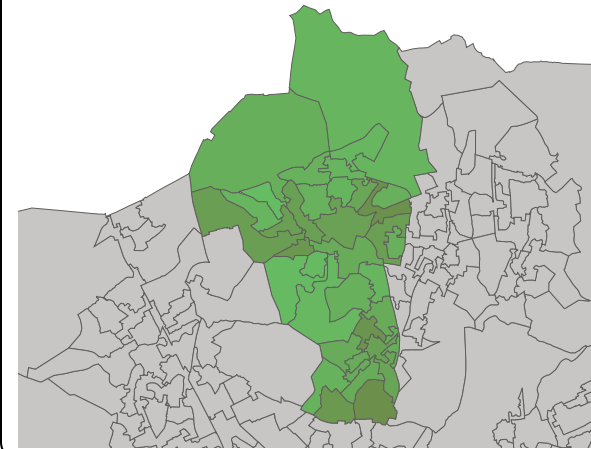

Reported Crimes 2021-23 by Category



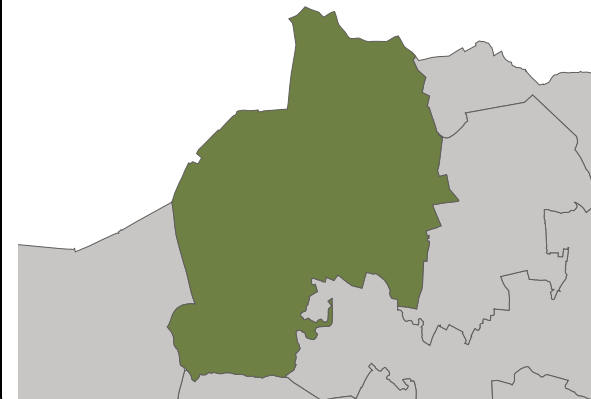

Crime Map Information

The areas of the map are coloured according to the crime rate per head of the population per year. Lower rates are green, middle rates are brown, and higher rates red. It is not possible to show background mapping at the moment, but hovering over an area gives the name of the neighbourhood.

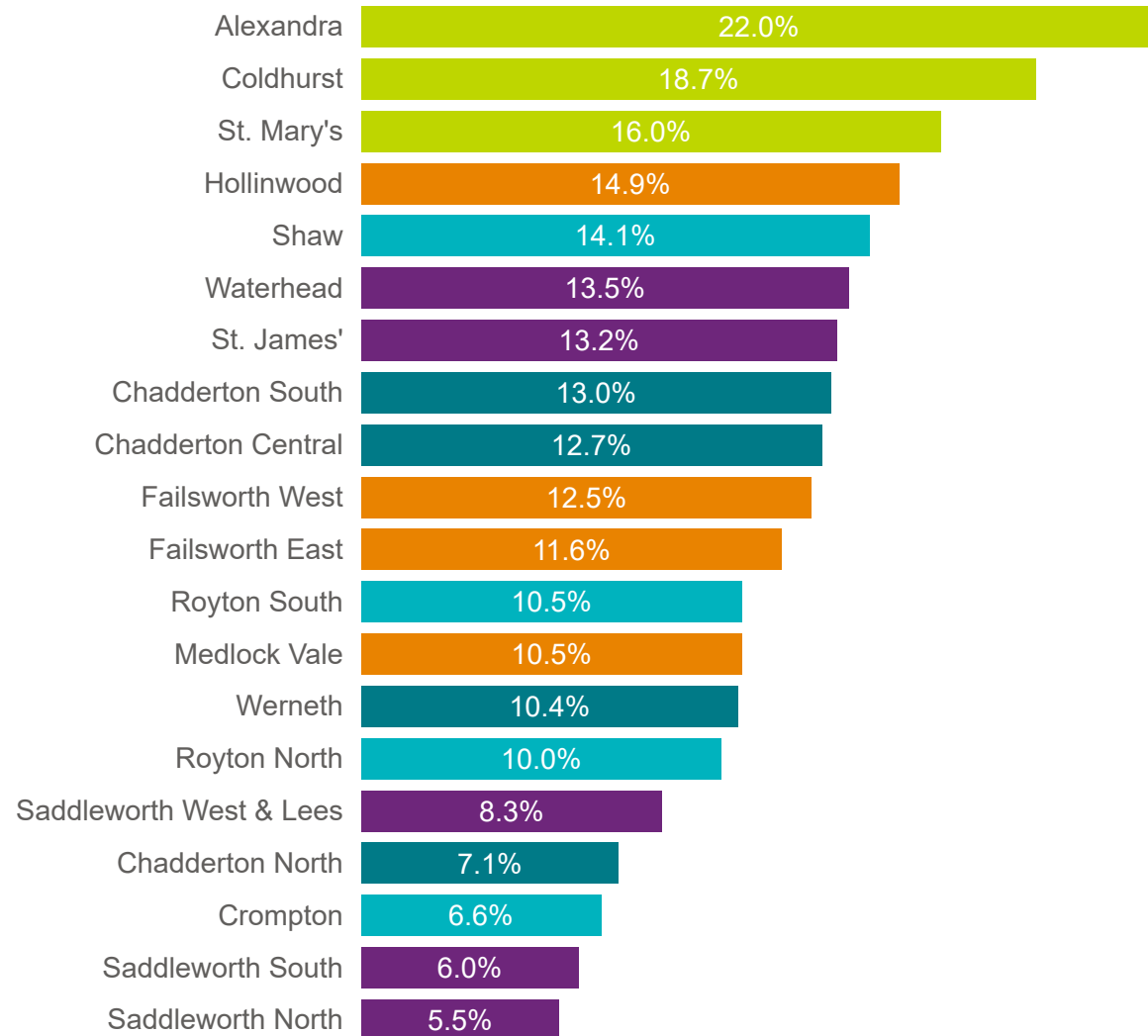
Trust Map Information

The map to the left shows data from [work by the 'Onward' organisation](#) that measures social trust. They surveyed residents, asking if others could be trusted. Where values are positive (coloured green), people tended to trust more. Negative values (red) are where people tend not to trust others. Grey areas are mainly or wholly in a different ward. The areas are Middle Super Output Areas (statistical areas)

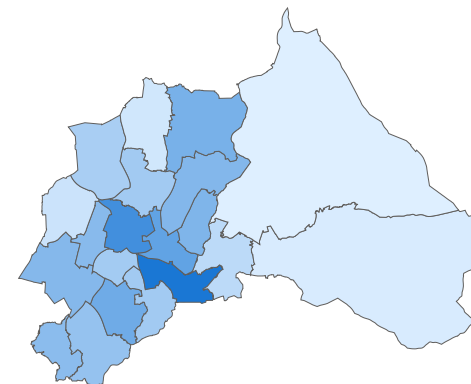

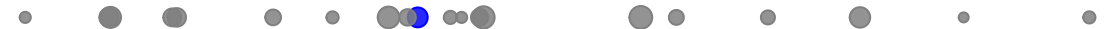

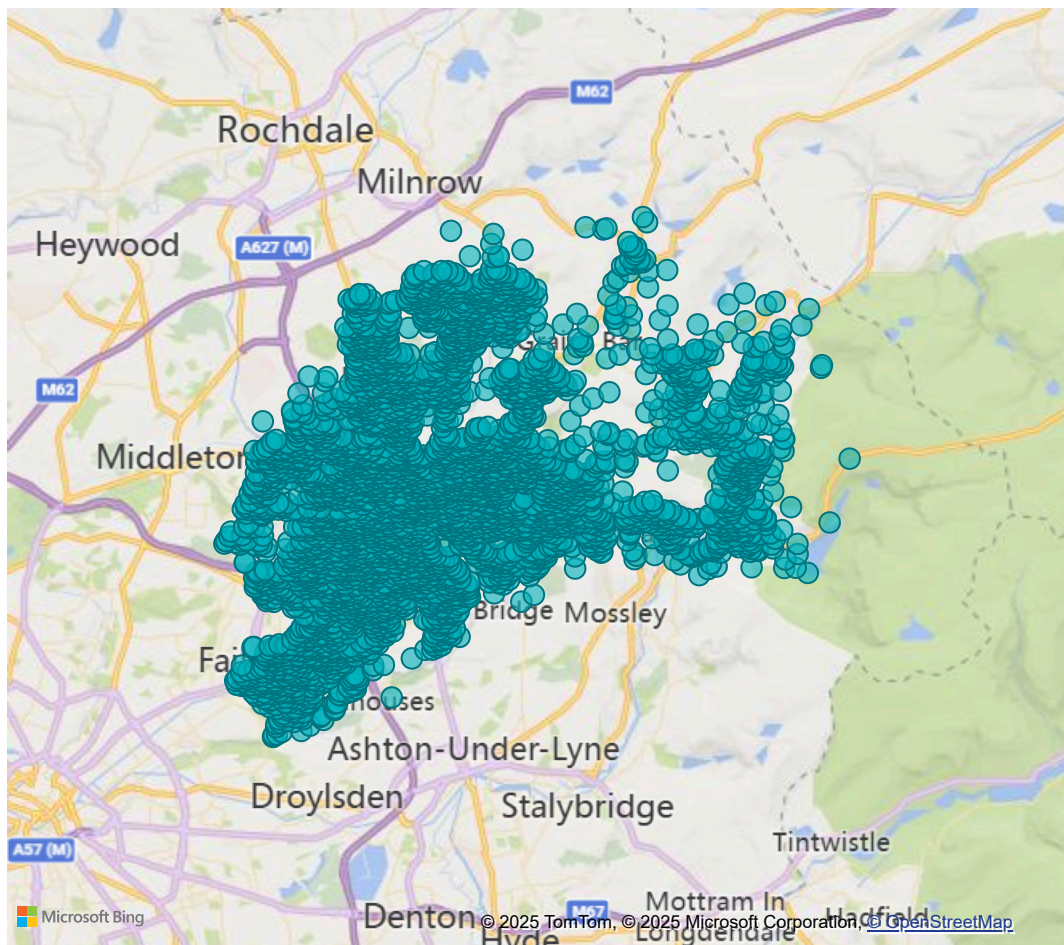
