Hollinwood

Population increased by 19% between 2011 and 2021.

Overall population is 74% White, school age population is 59% White.

Both GLD and Attainment 8 (GCSE) are below the Oldham average.

Median household income is 16% lower than the Oldham average.

9% of households are overcrowded, just below the Oldham average (10%).

2nd lowest rate of obesity in Year 6 in the borough (24%).

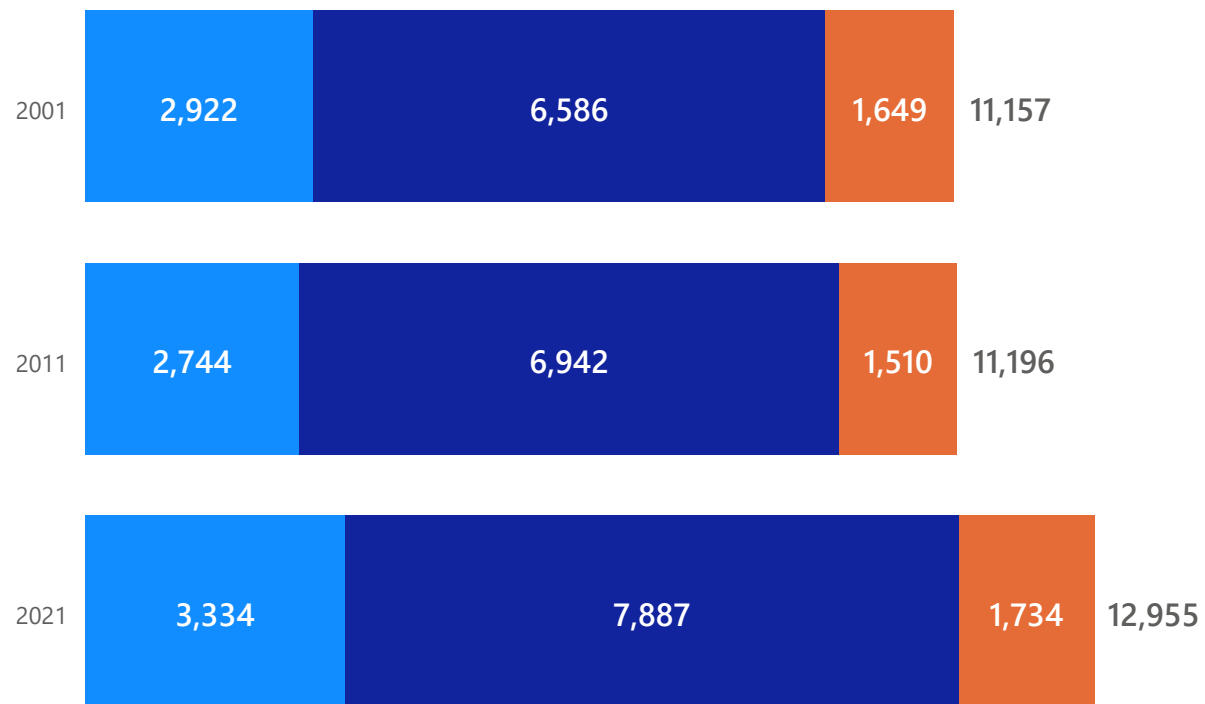

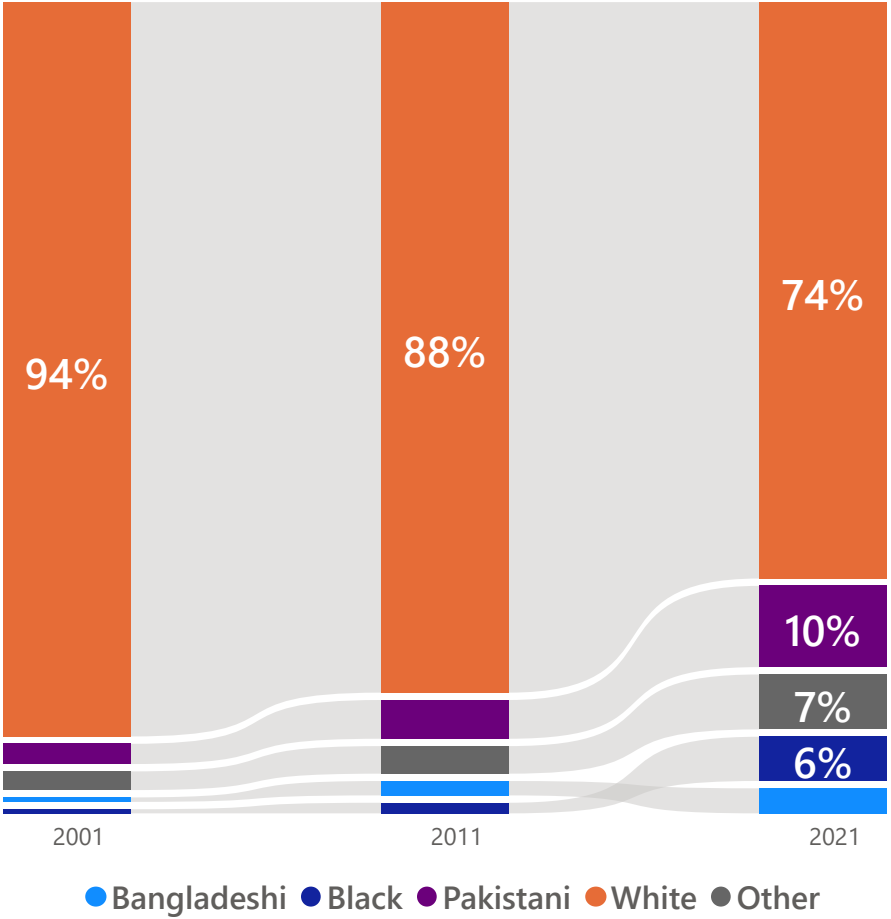

Ethnicity by Year (Percentage)



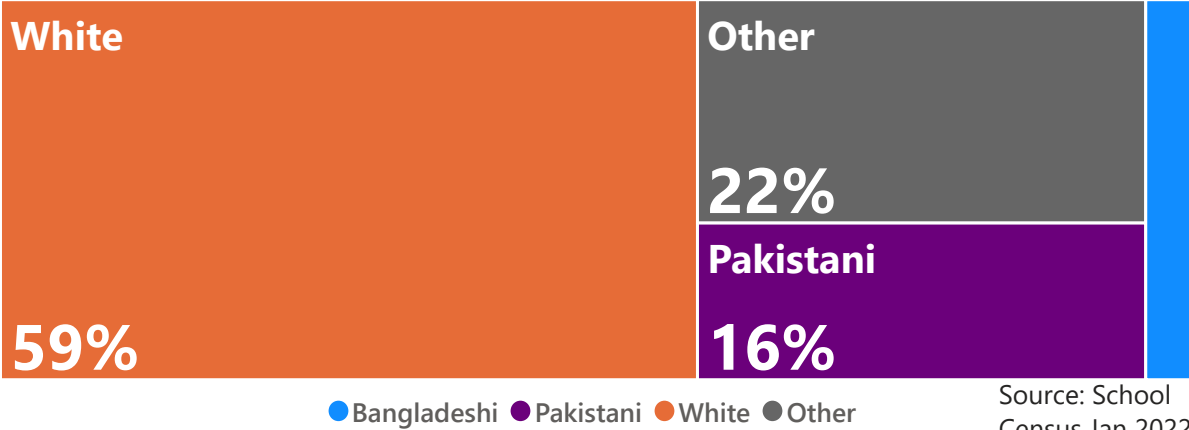

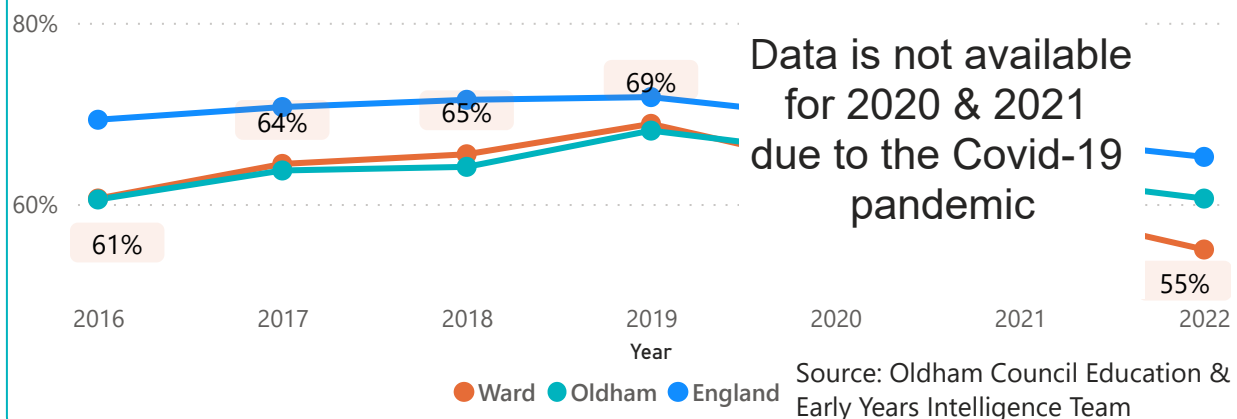

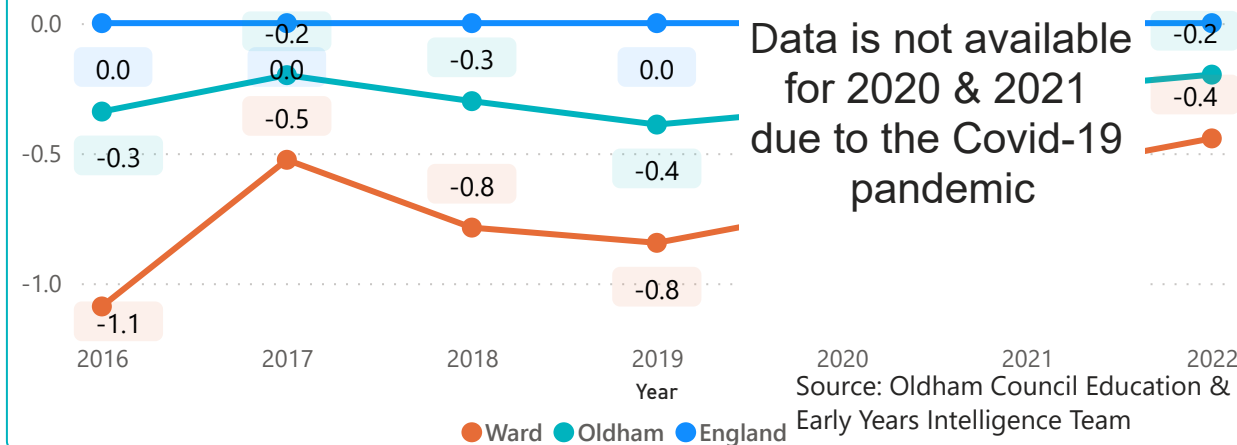

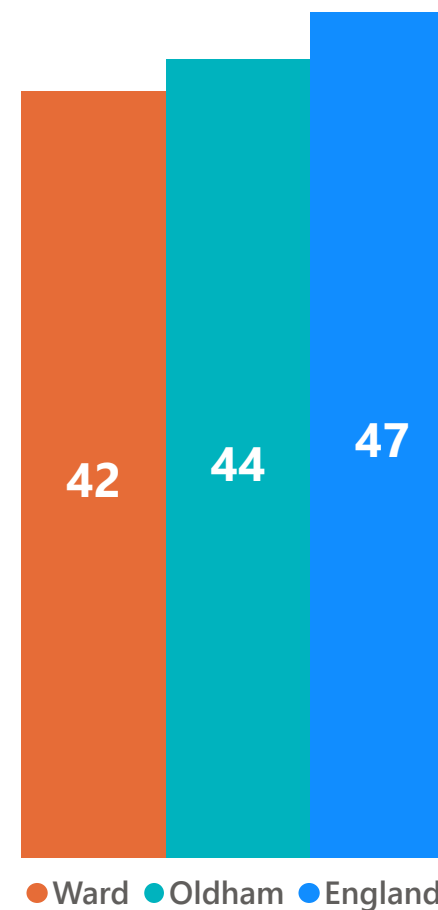
Children achieving a good level of development by the end of reception

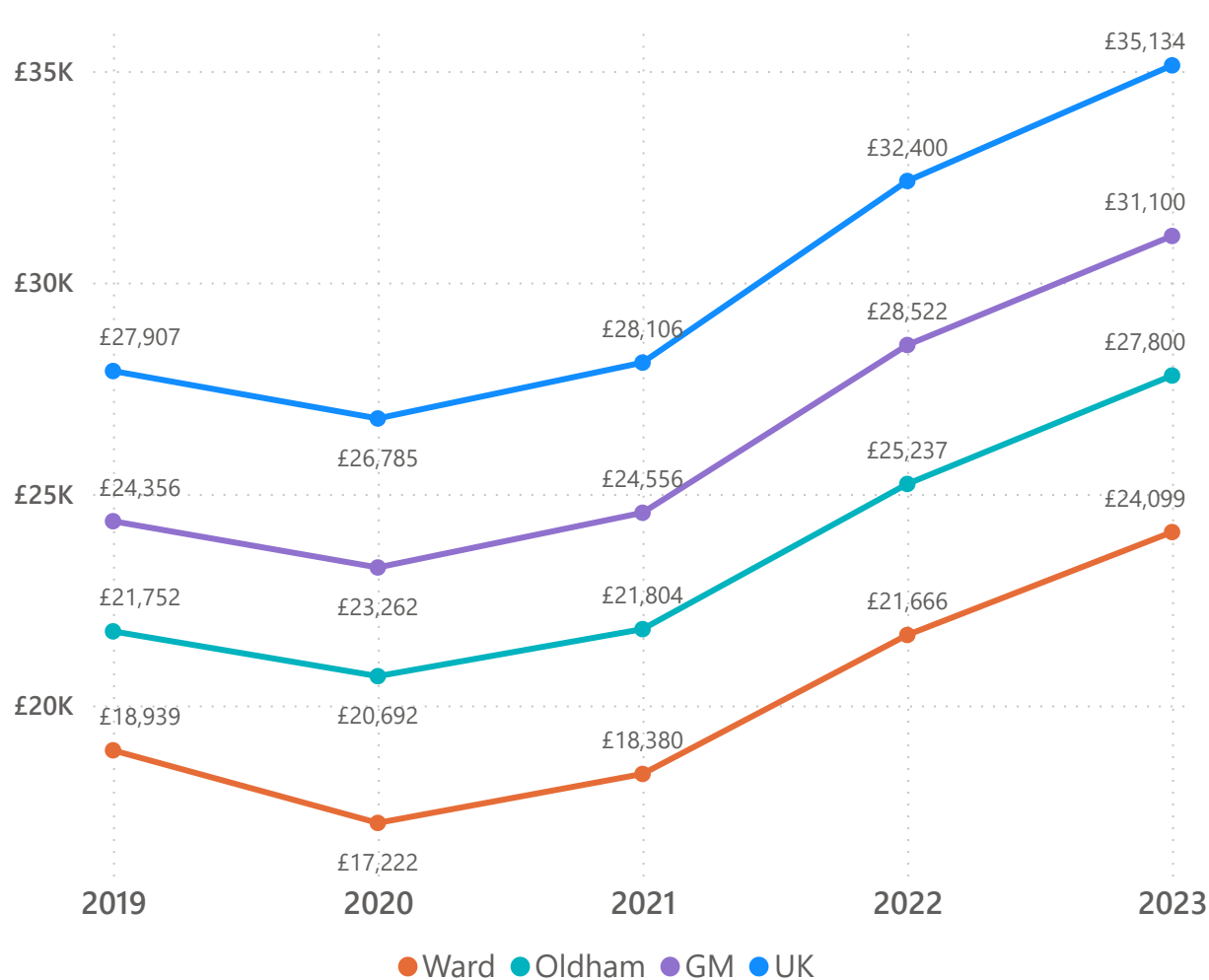

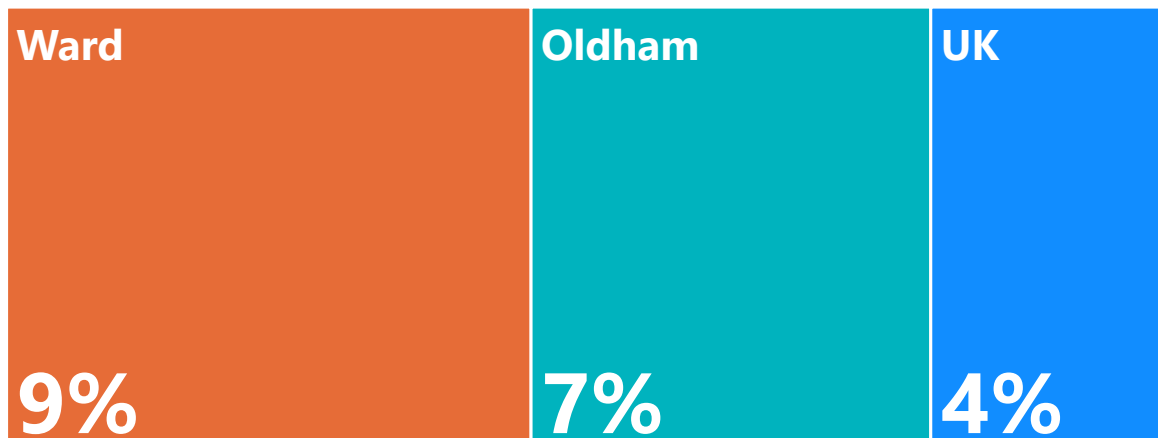

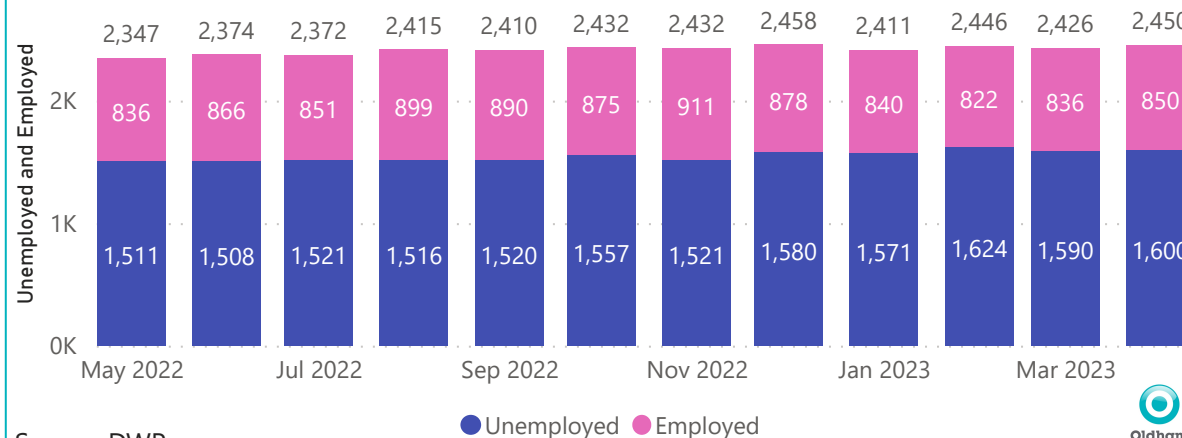

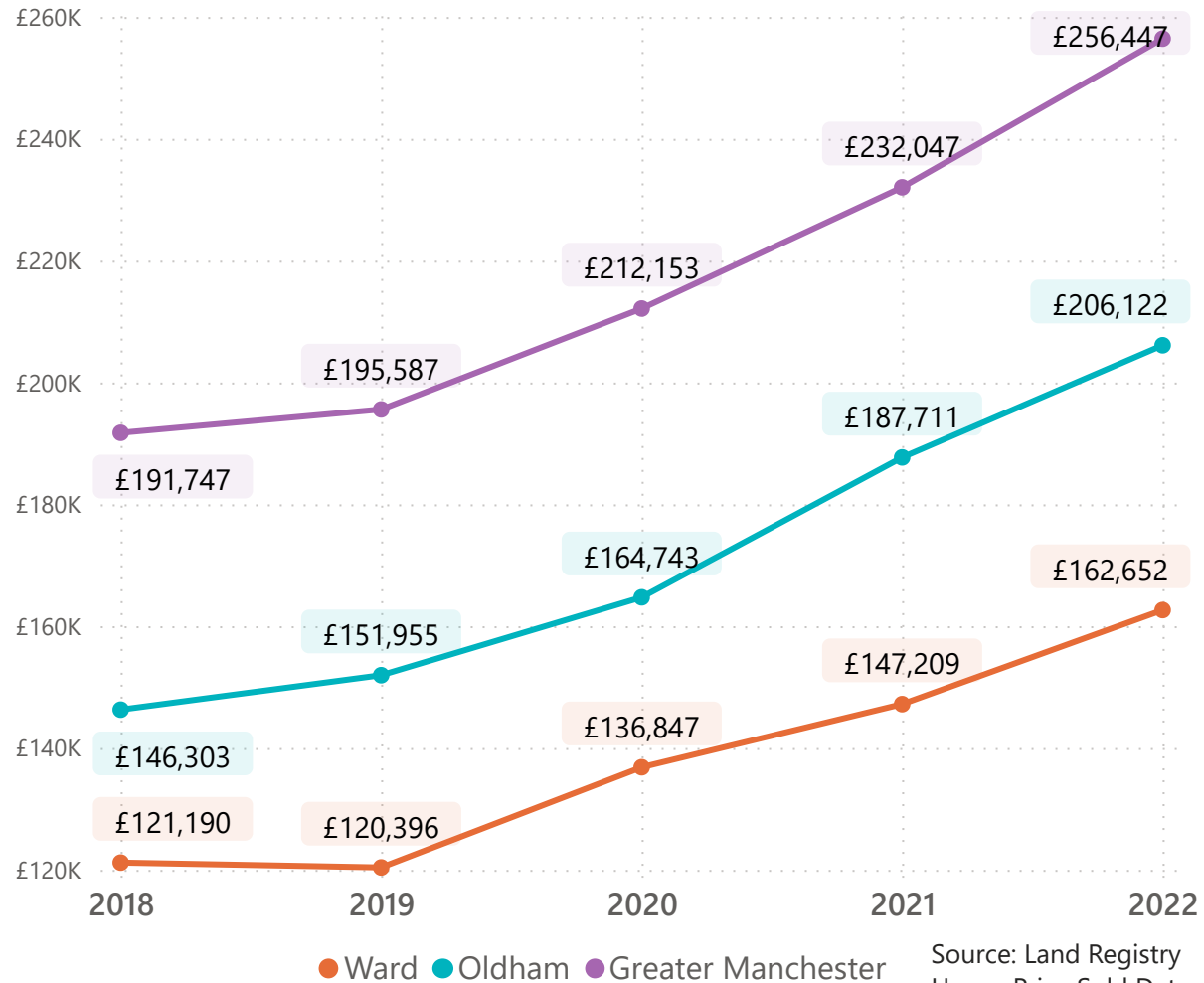

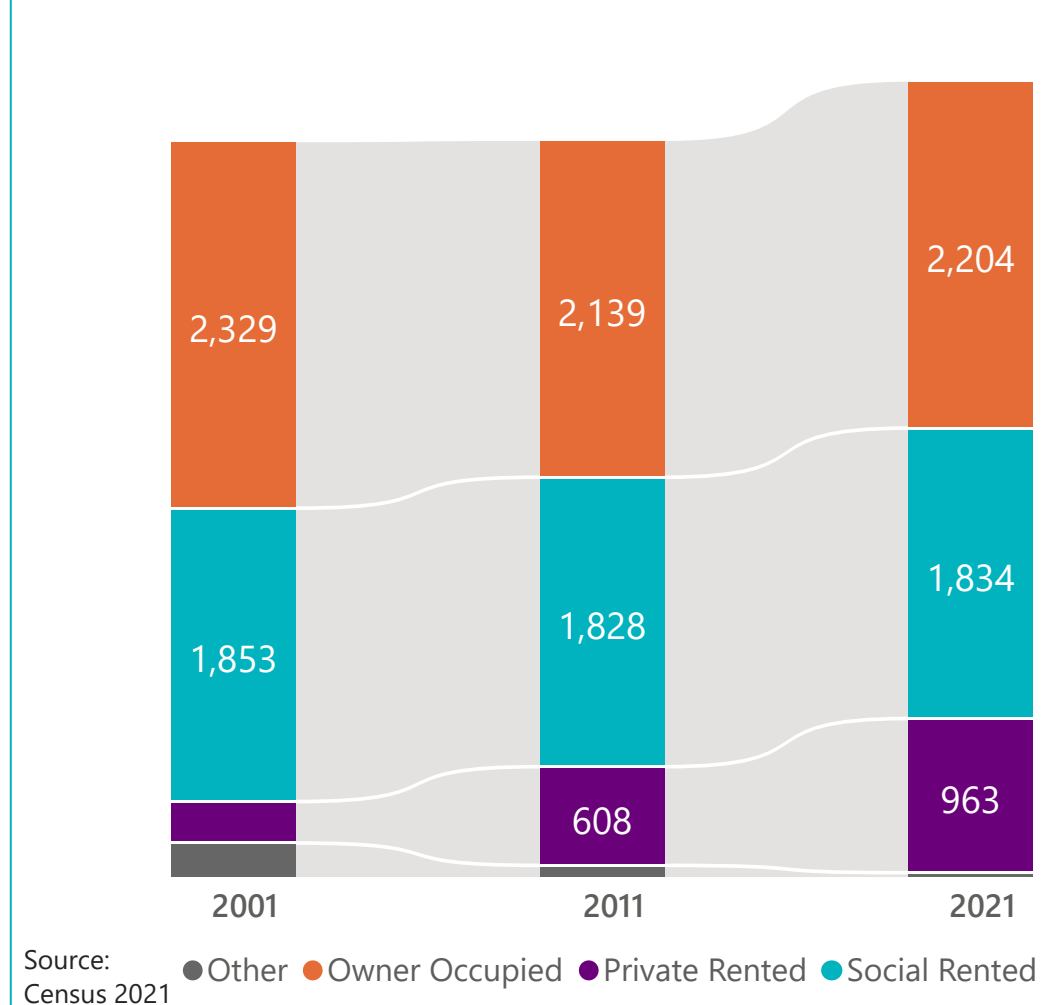

Housing Tenure by Year



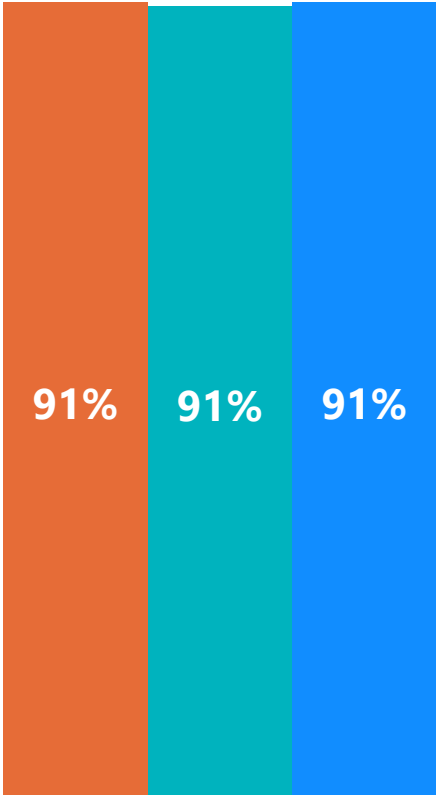

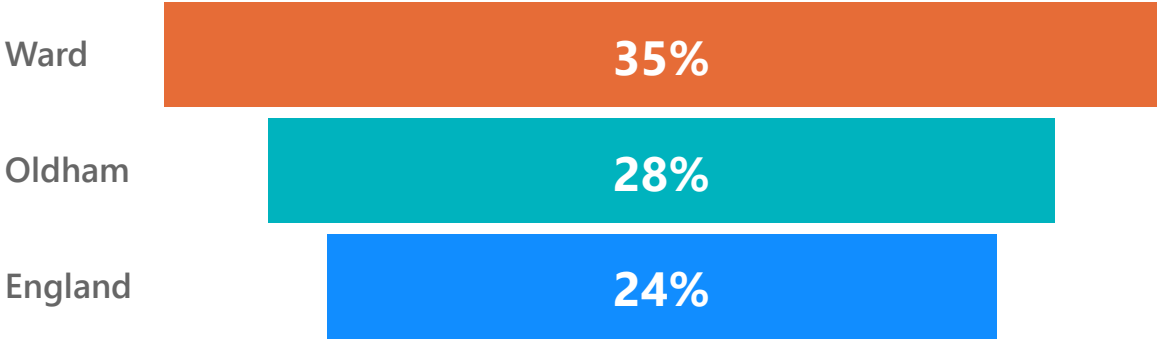
Adult Population Registered to Vote

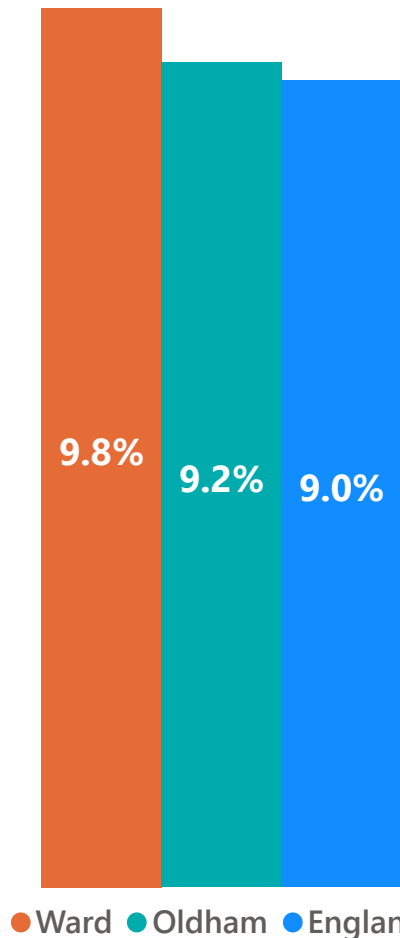

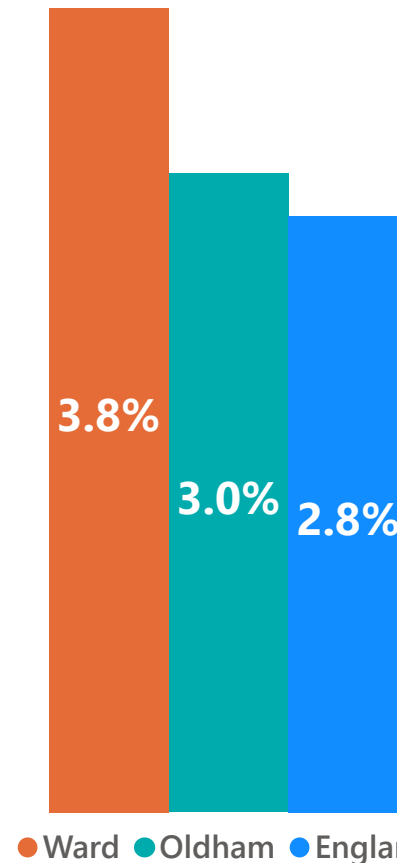

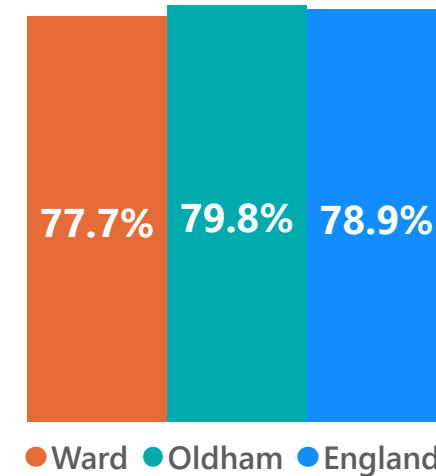

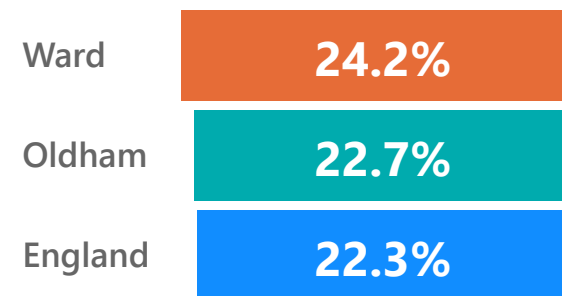


General Health 'Good' or 'Very Good'

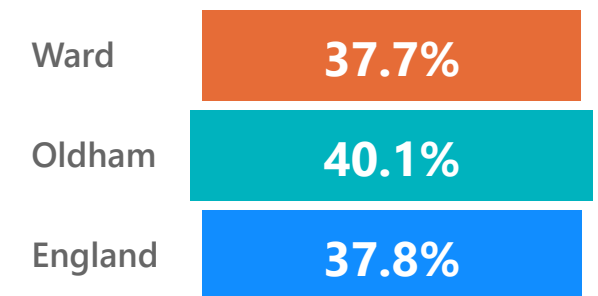
