Summary

Medlock Vale

Population increased by 15% between 2011 and 2021.

In 2001, population was 77% White, 13% Pakistani. In 2021, population is 50% White, 29% Pakistani.

Both GLD and Attainment 8 (GCSE) are below the Oldham average.

Median household income is 13% lower than the Oldham average.

15% of households are overcrowded, more than the Oldham average (10%).

Rate of obesity in Year 6 (27%) is 13% lower than the Oldham average (40%).

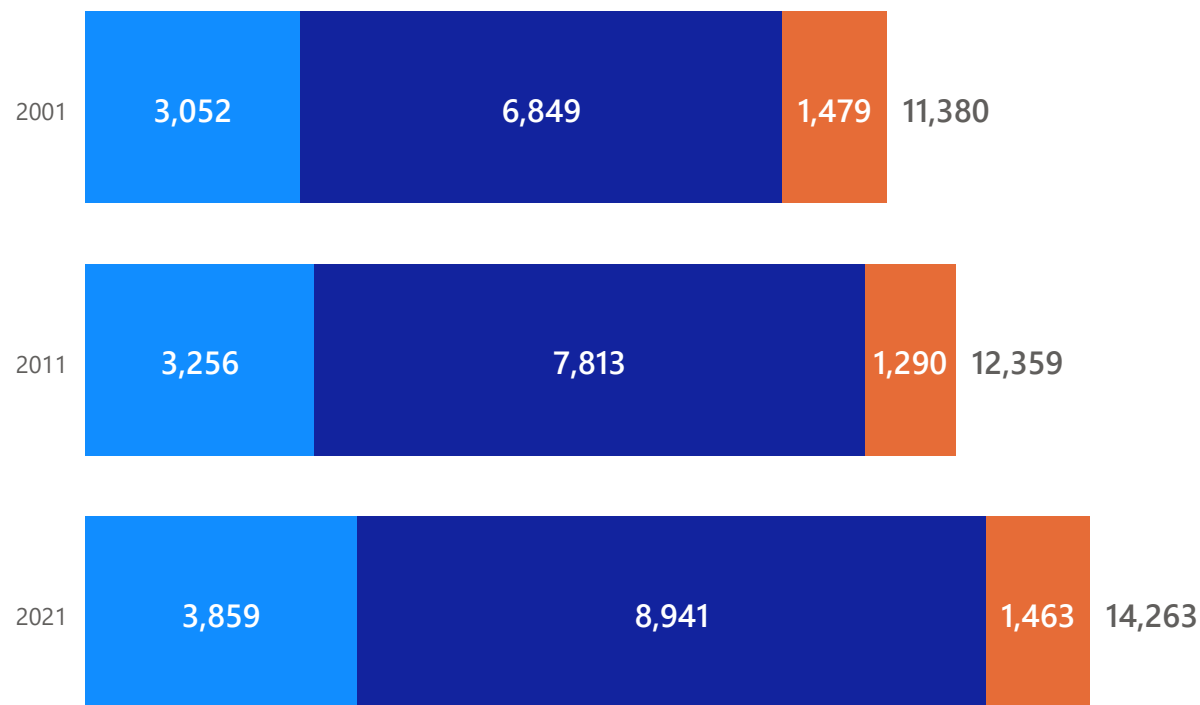

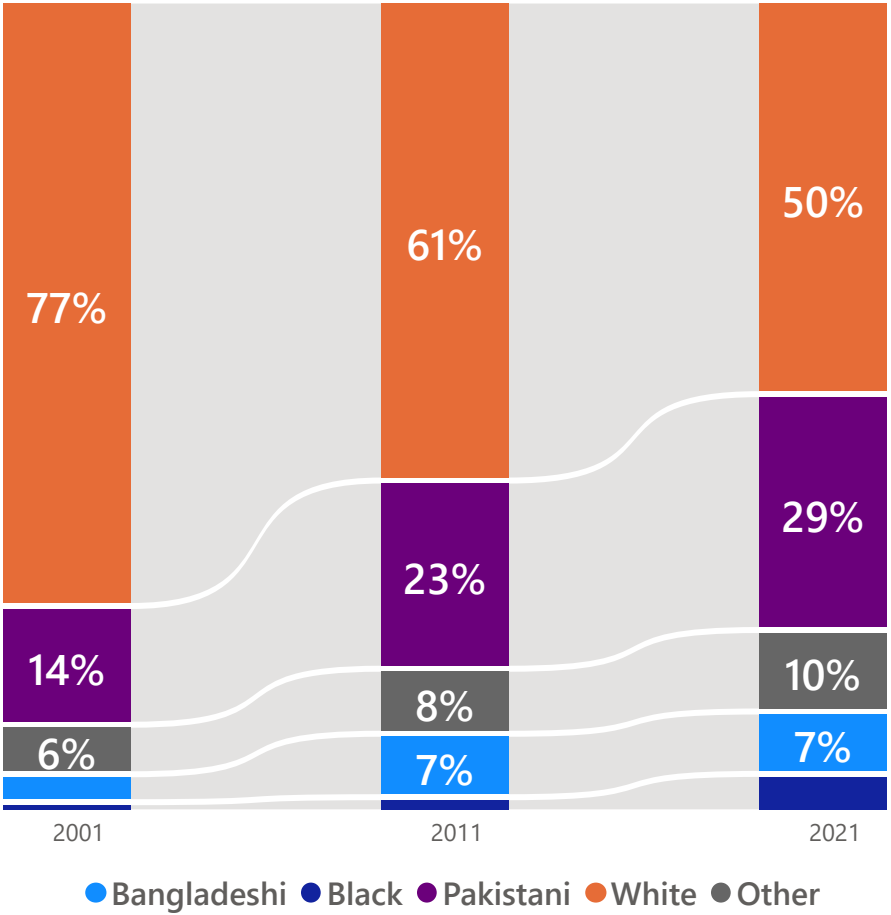

Ethnicity by Year (Percentage)



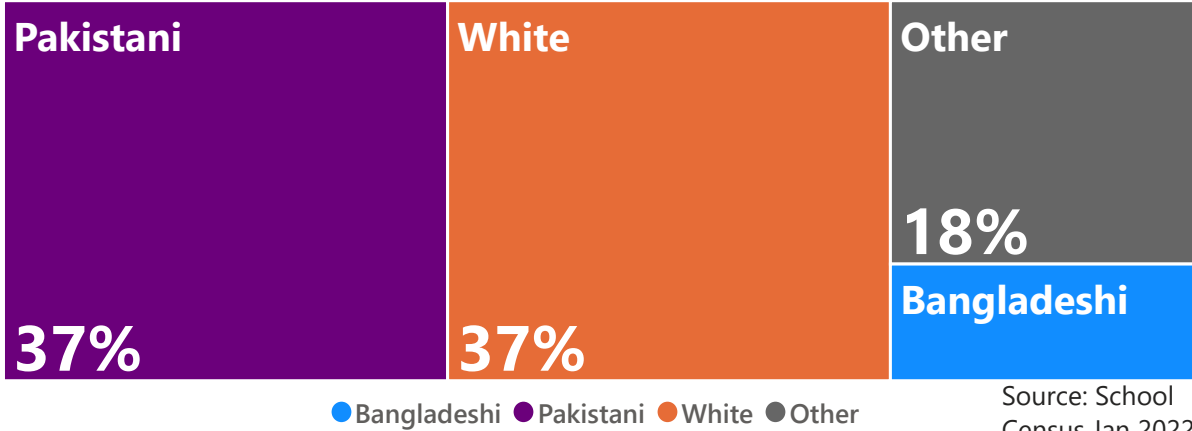

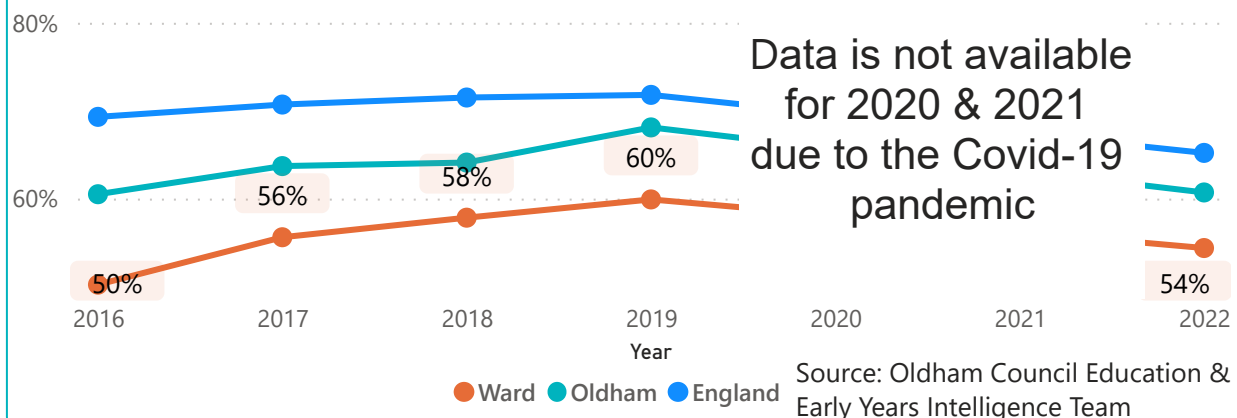

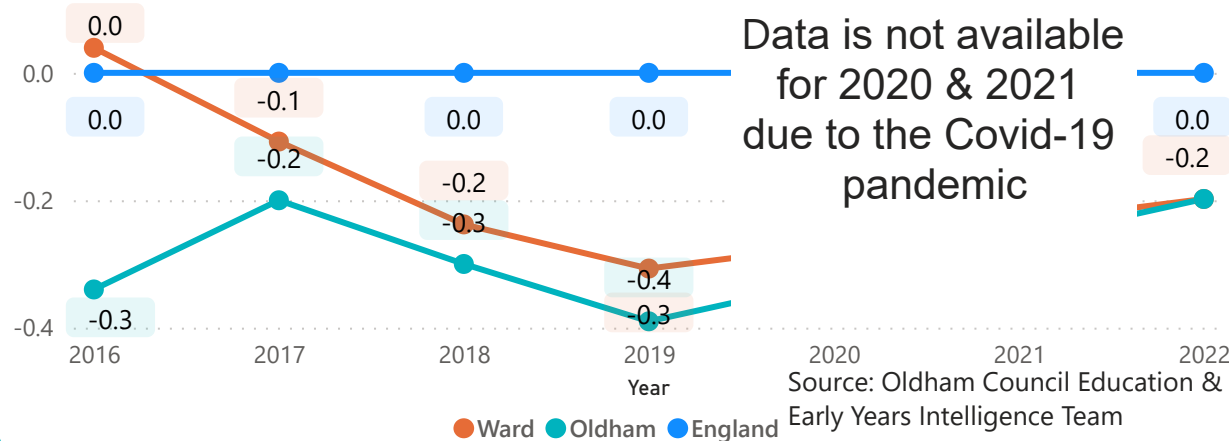

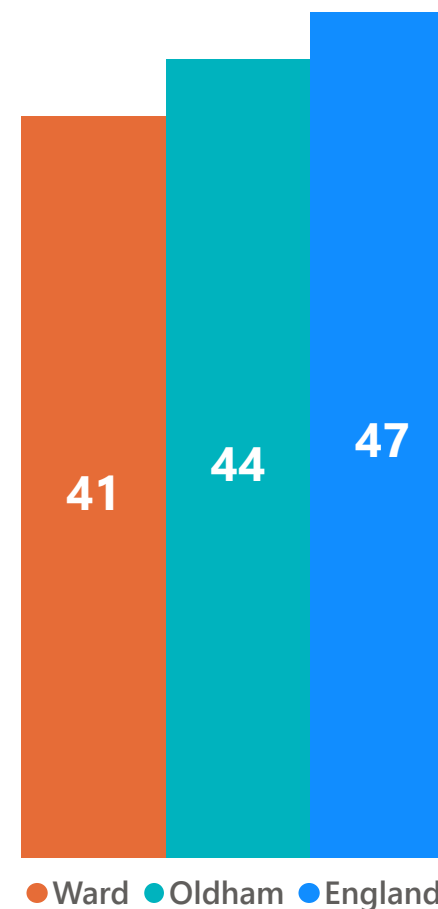
Children achieving a good level of development by the end of reception

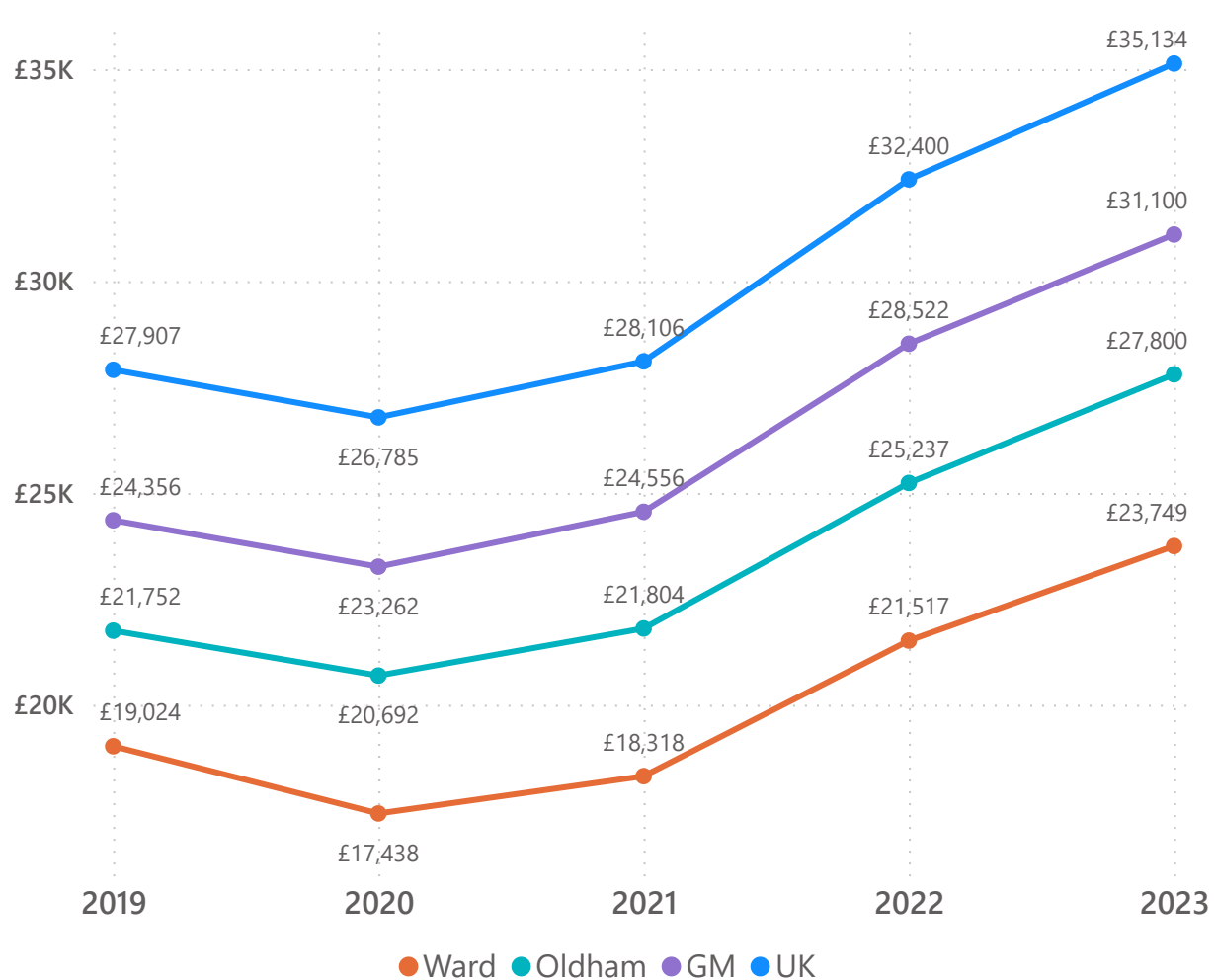

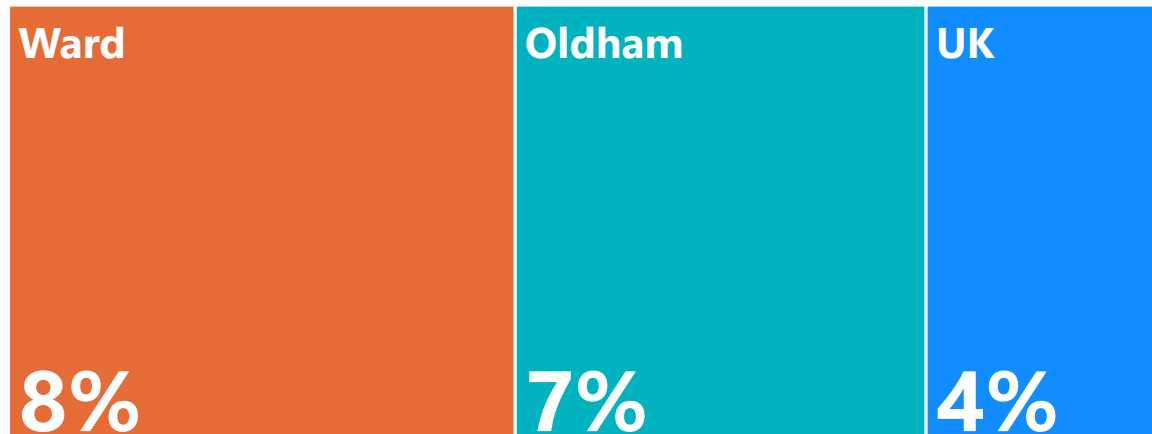

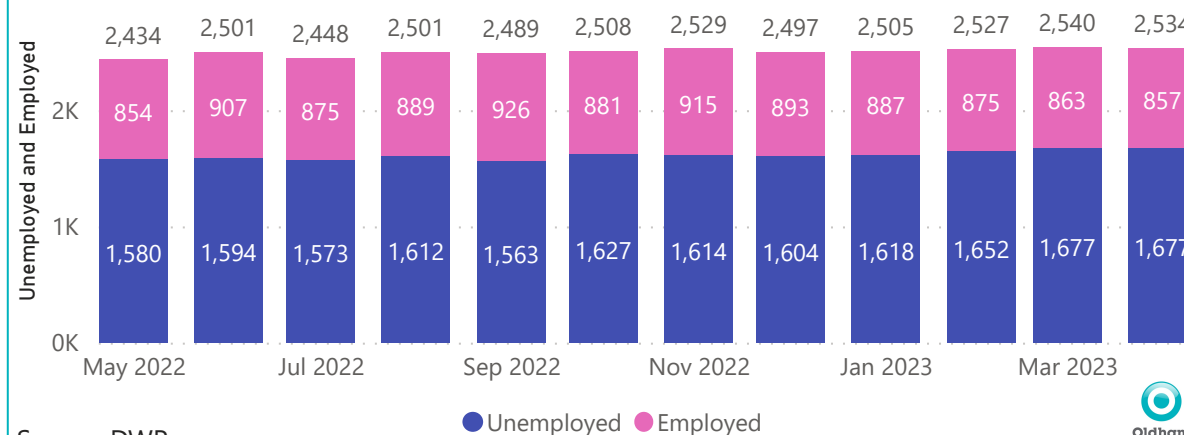

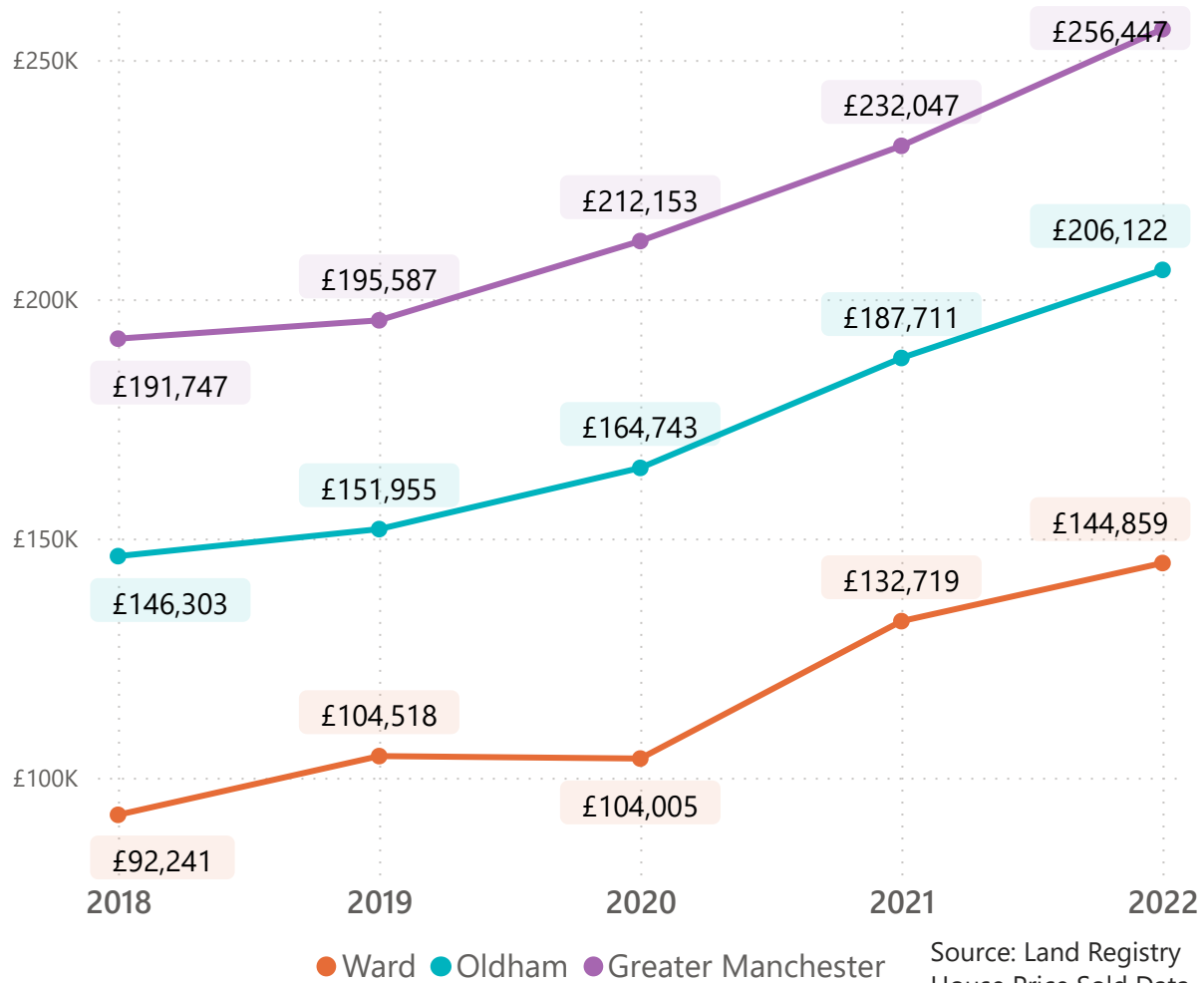

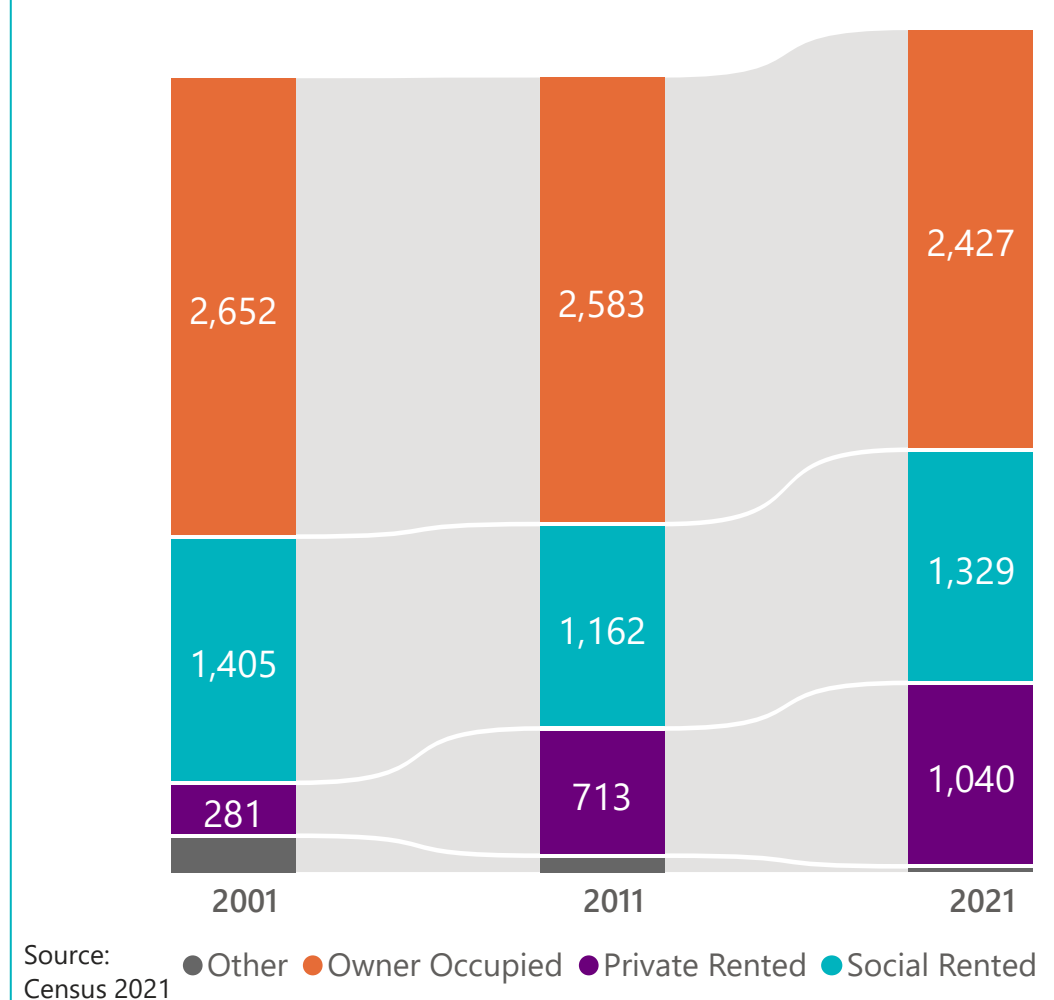

Housing Tenure by Year



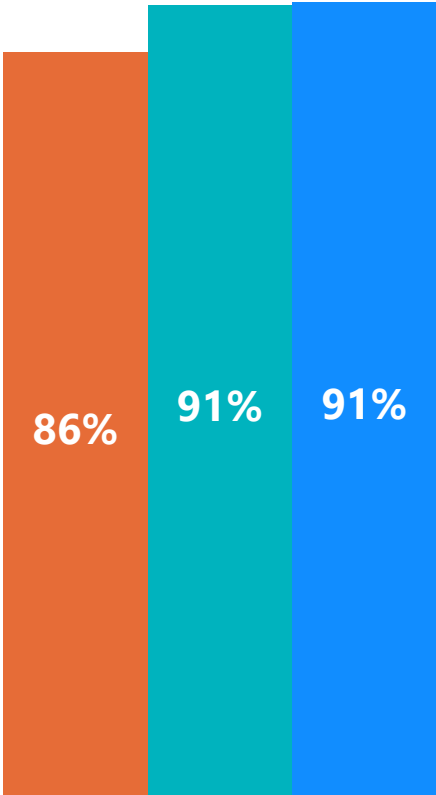

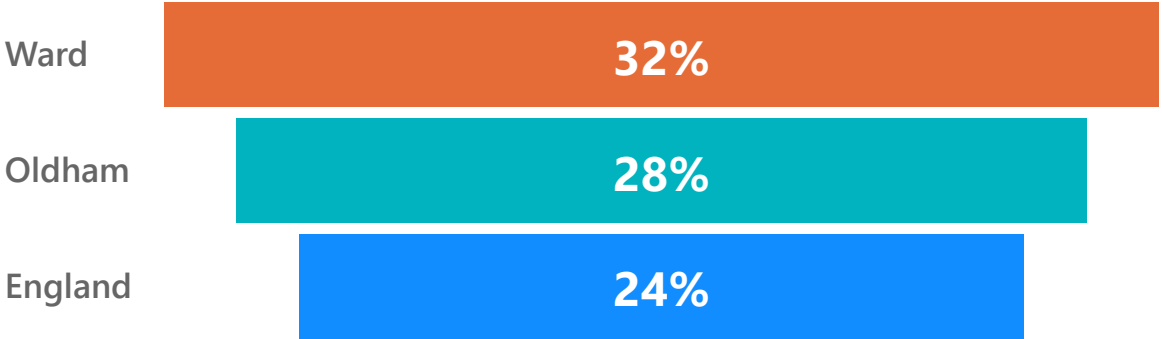
Adult Population Registered to Vote

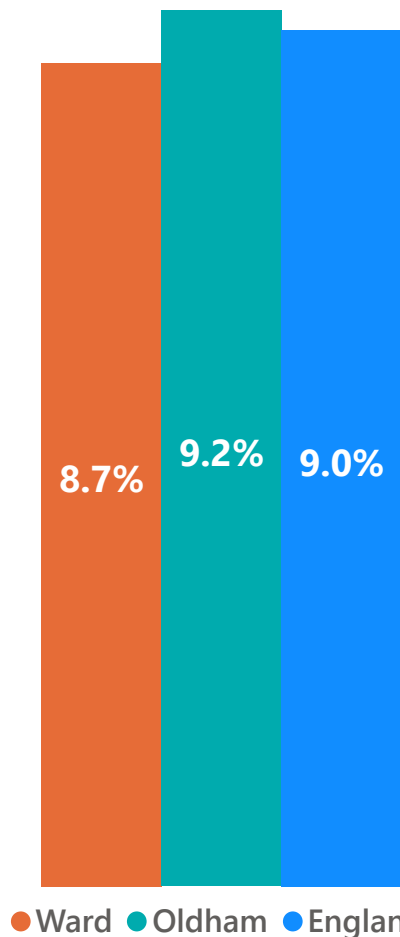

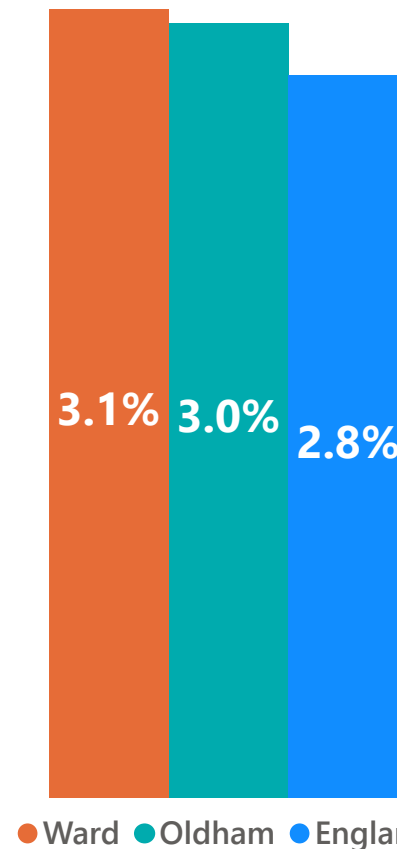

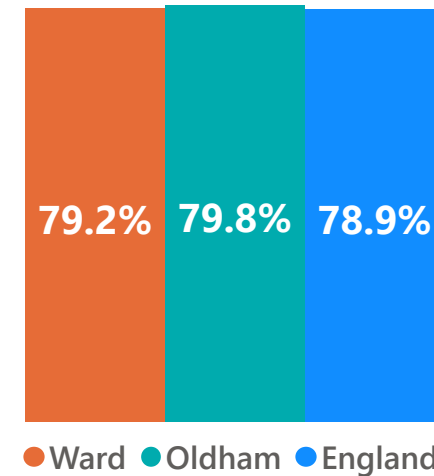

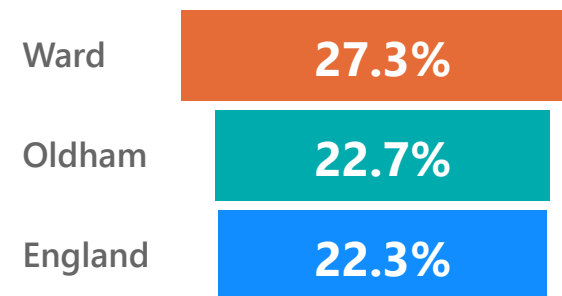


General Health 'Good' or 'Very Good'

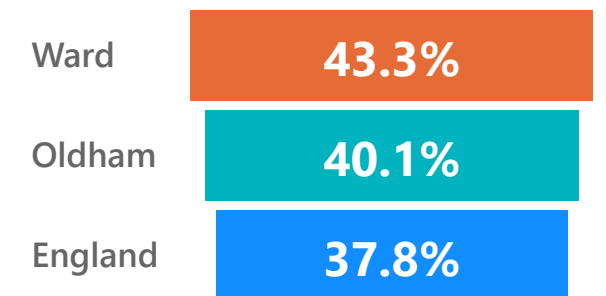
