### **Shaw Ward: An Introduction**




Shaw has a very strong local identity and the ward profiles tell us that there is above average satisfaction rate amongst resident with Shaw as a place to live.





### **Crime Map Information**

### **Trust Map Information**


The map to the left shows data from work by the 'Onward' organisation that measures social trust. They surveyed residents, asking if others could be trusted.

Where values are positive (coloured green), people tended to trust more. Negative values (red) are where people tend not to trust others.


Grey areas are mainly or wholly in a different ward. The areas are Middle Super Output Areas (statistical areas)




