Summary

St Mary's

Is the 2nd largest ward by population in the borough with 15,033 residents. The population size increased by 8% since 2011.

55% of residents are Pakistani, the largest proportion of any ward in Oldham.

Both GLD and Attainment 8 (GCSE) scores are below the Oldham average. 2nd lowest Attainment 8 (GCSE) score in the borough.

Median household income is lower than the Oldham average, and the gap widened between 2021 and 2022.

The highest rate of fuel poverty in the borough (27%).

Rate of obesity in Year 6 (41%) is 1% higher than the Oldham average (40%).

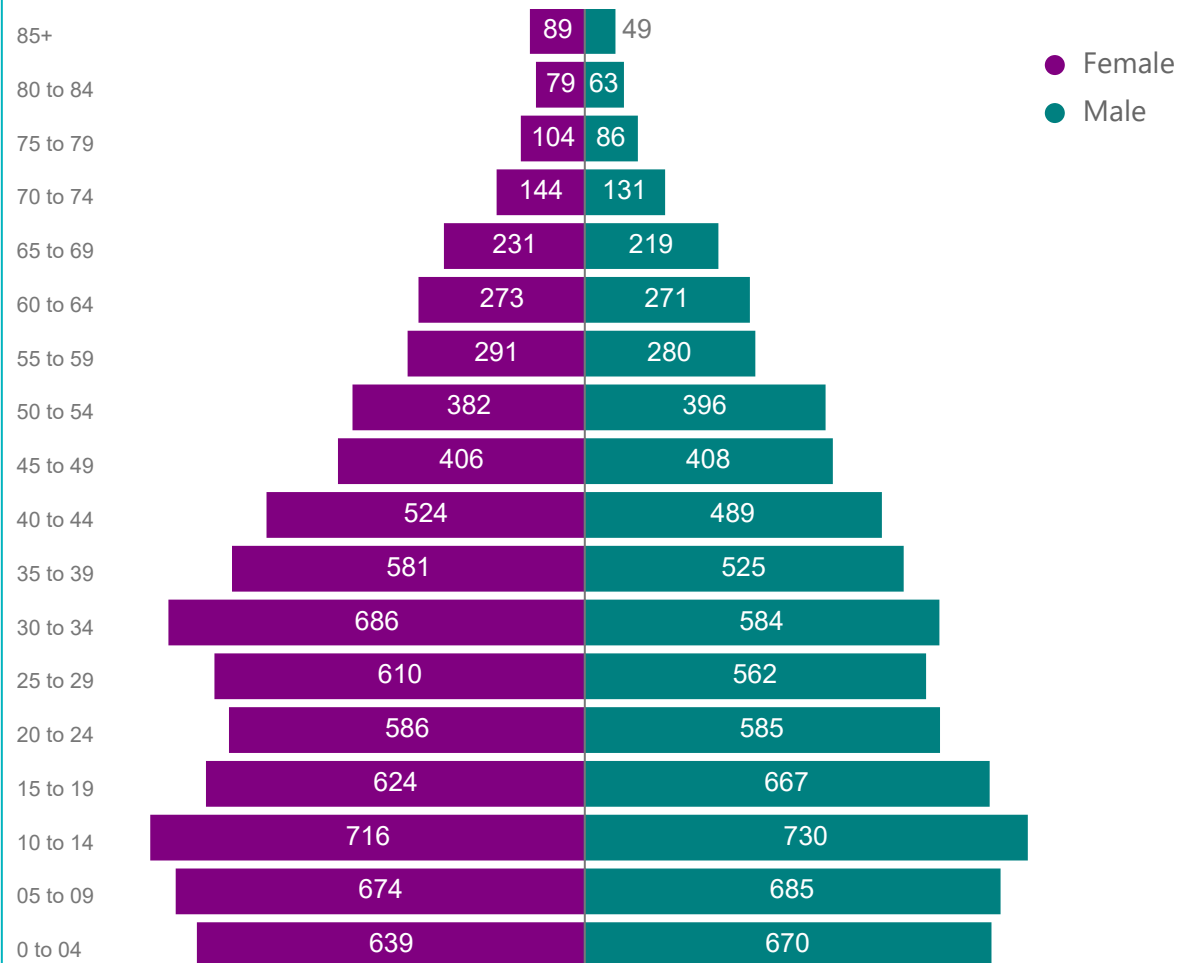

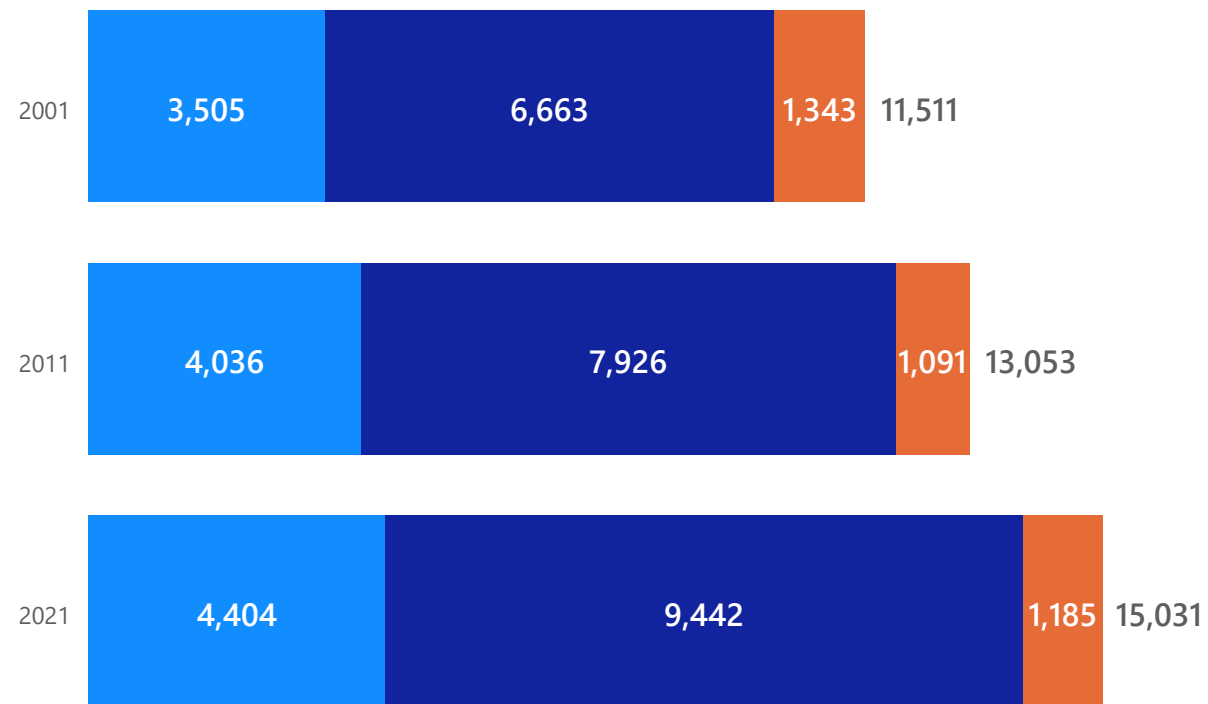

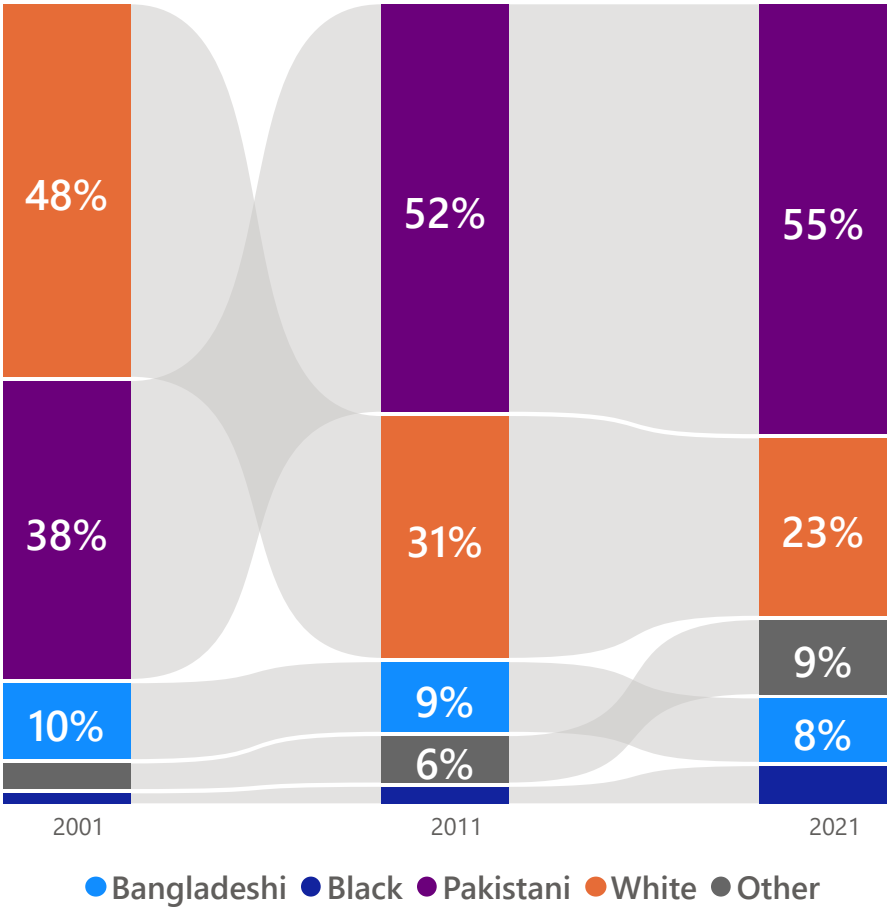

Ethnicity by Year (Percentage)



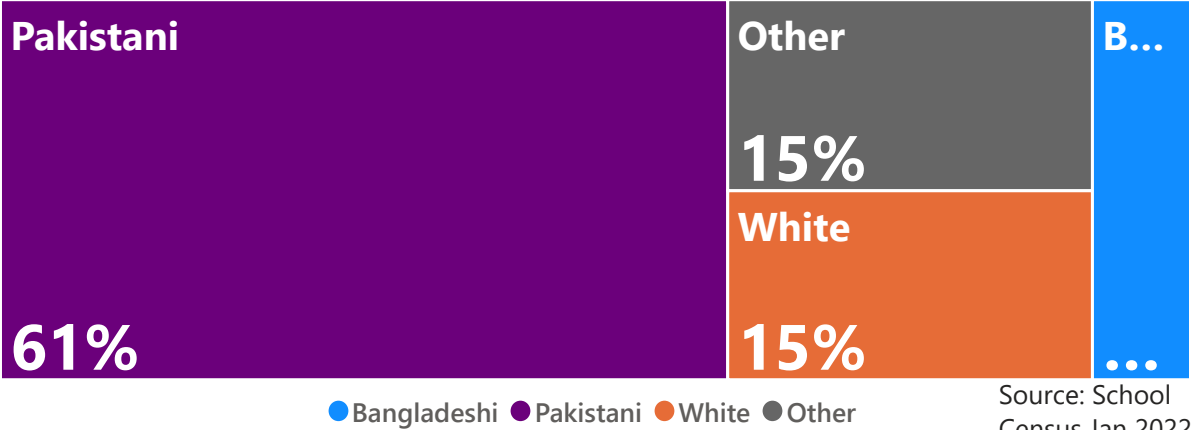

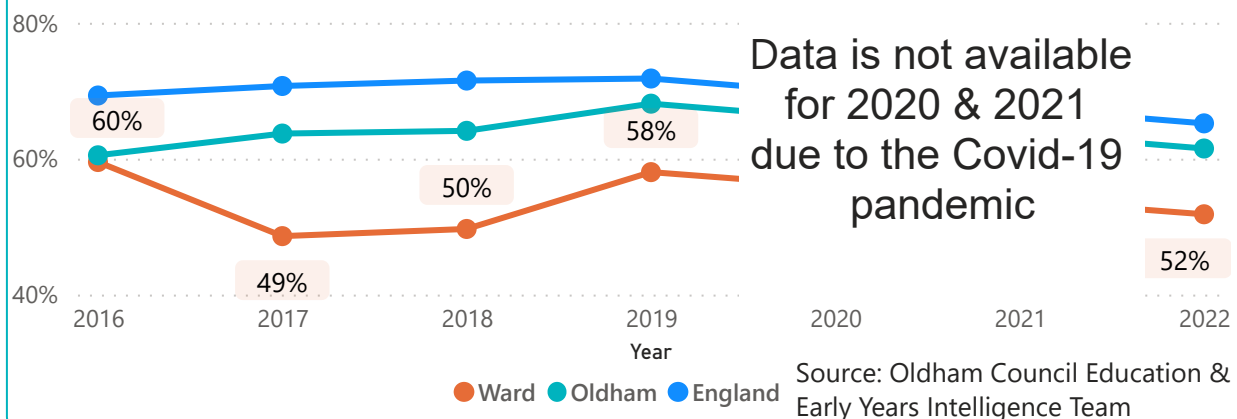

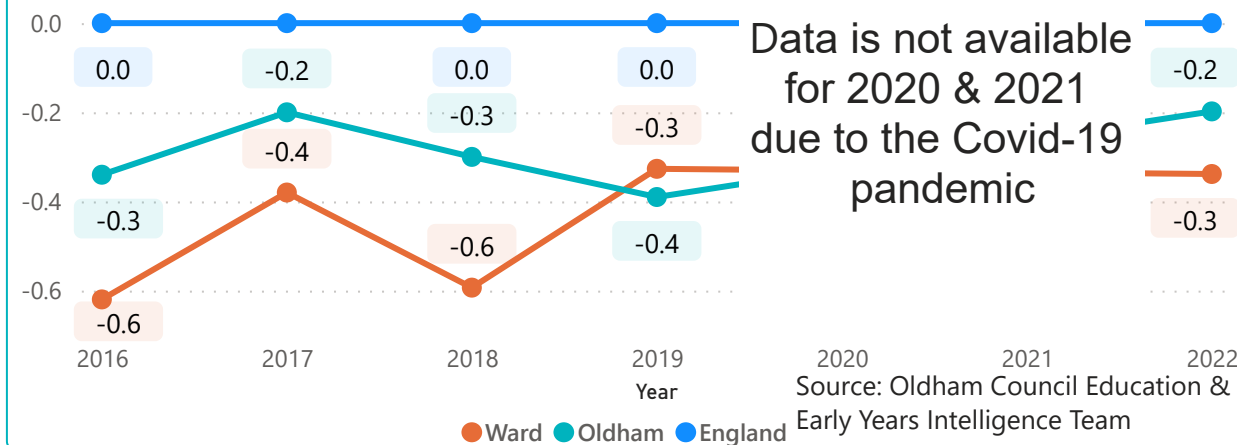

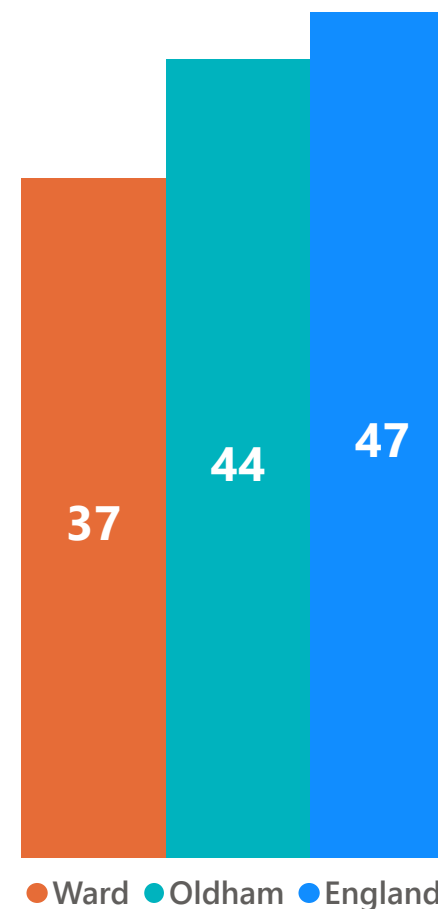
Children achieving a good level of development by the end of reception

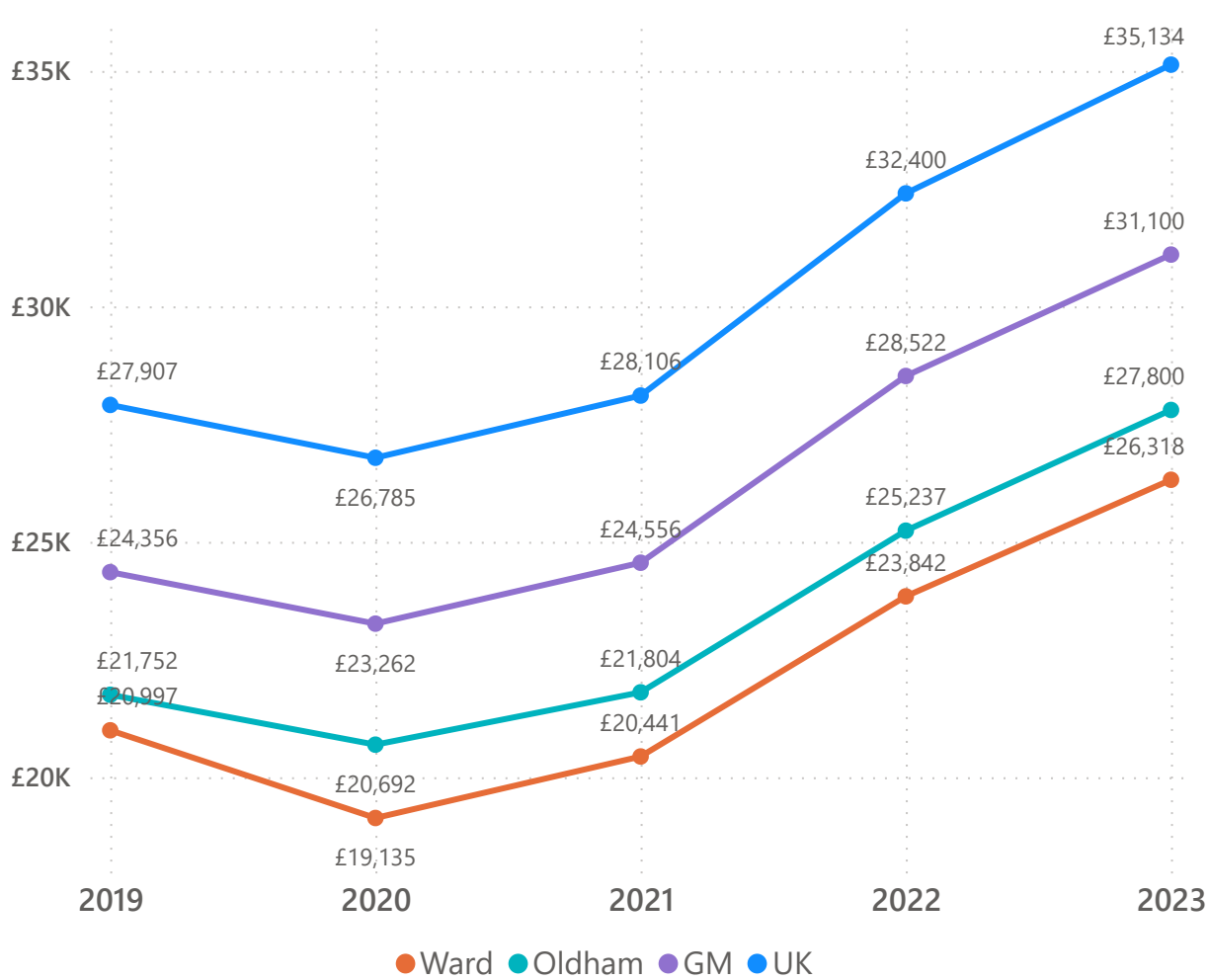

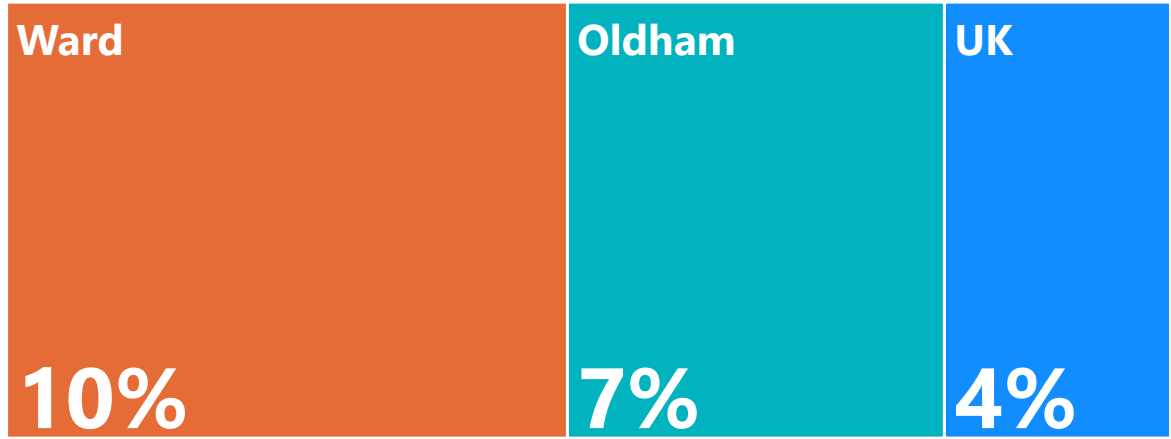

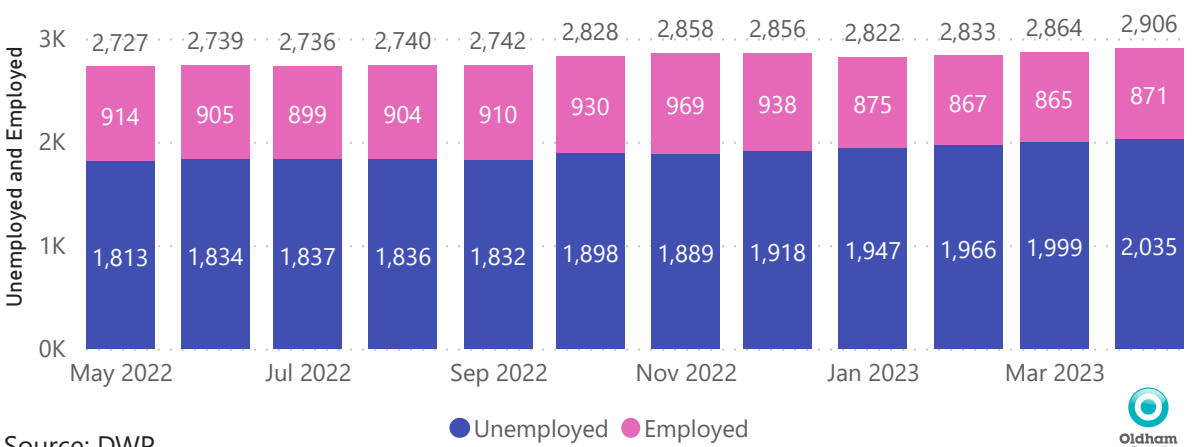

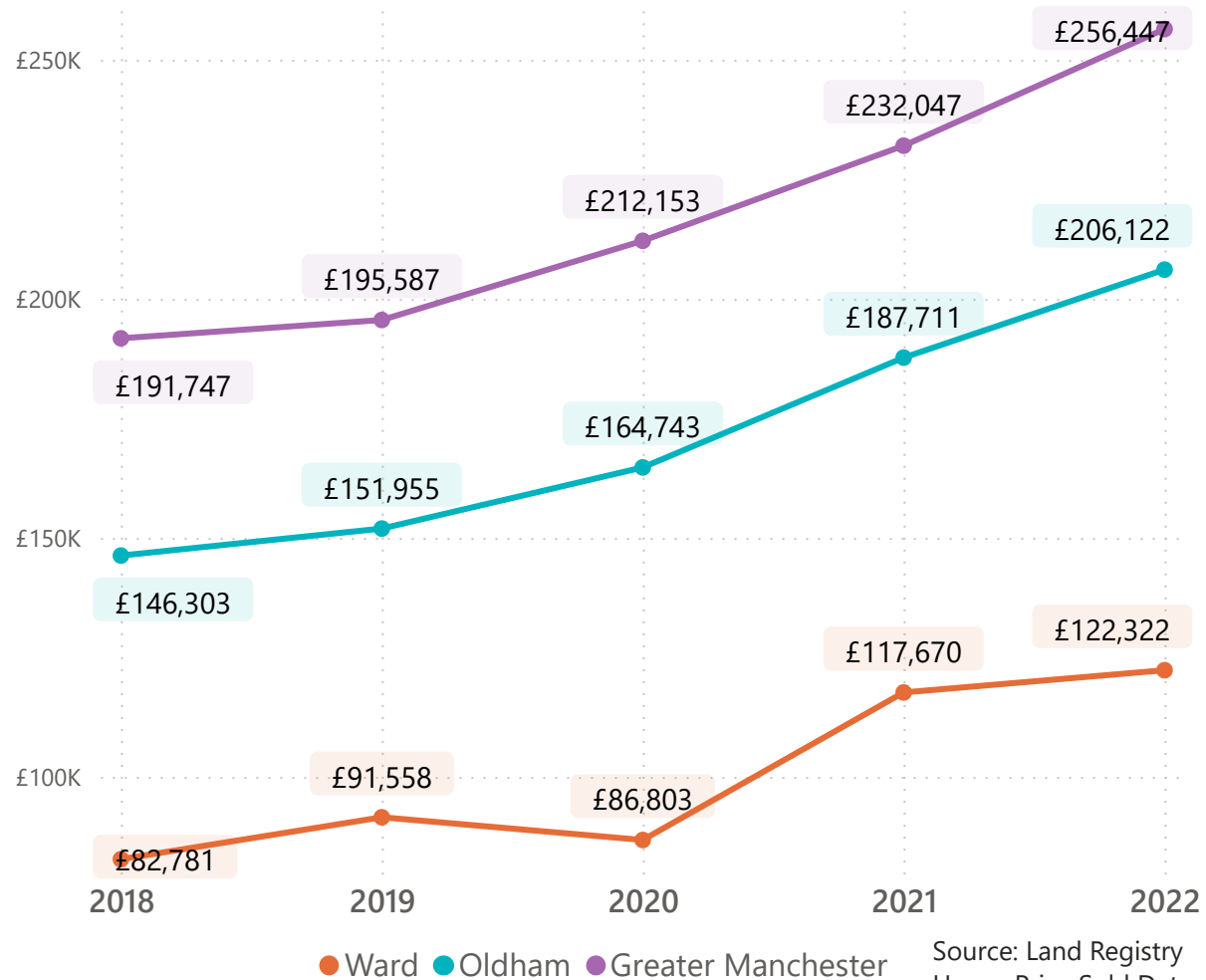

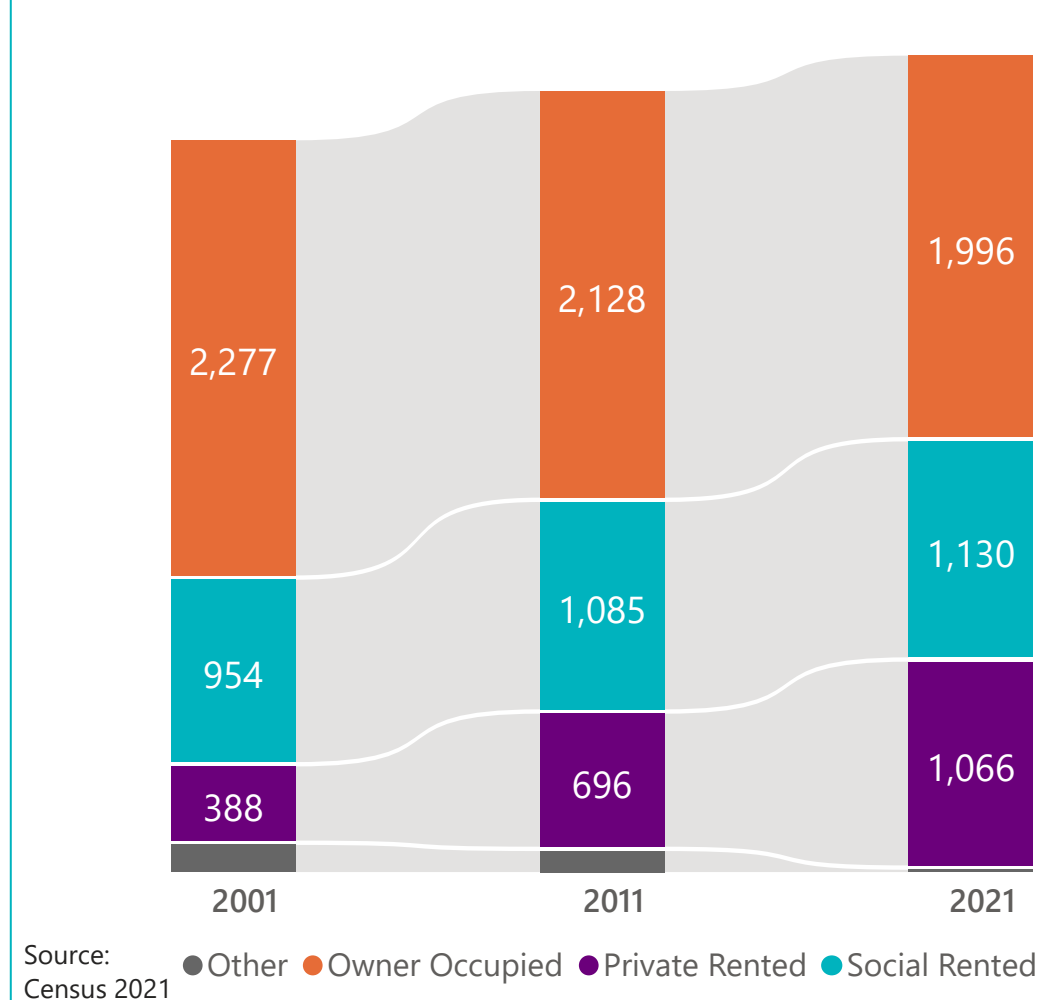

Housing Tenure by Year



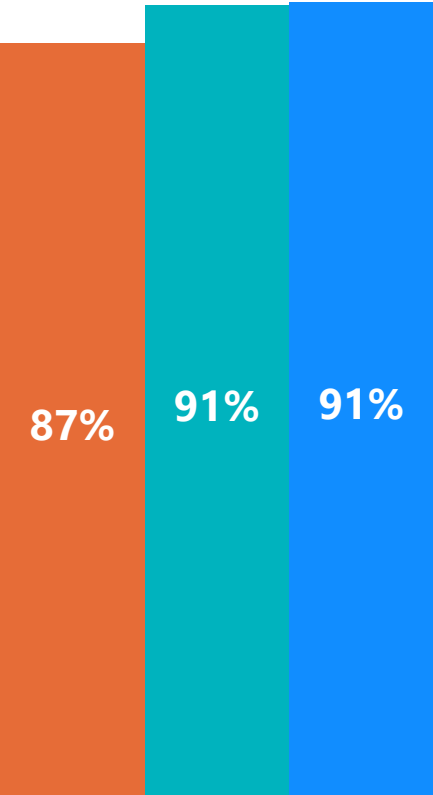

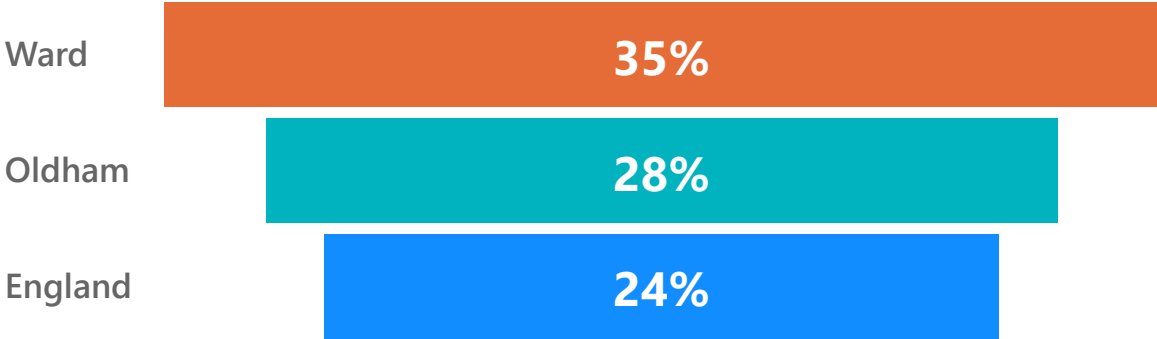
Adult Population Registered to Vote

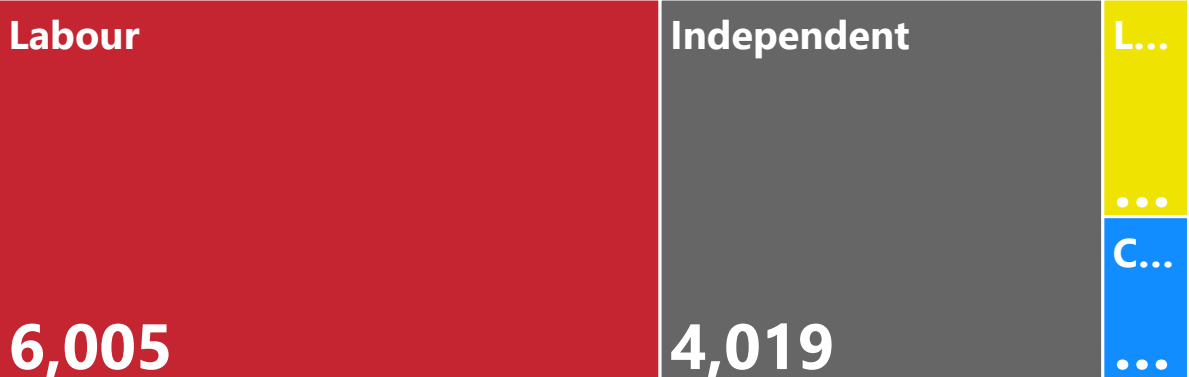
Households with No Car or Van

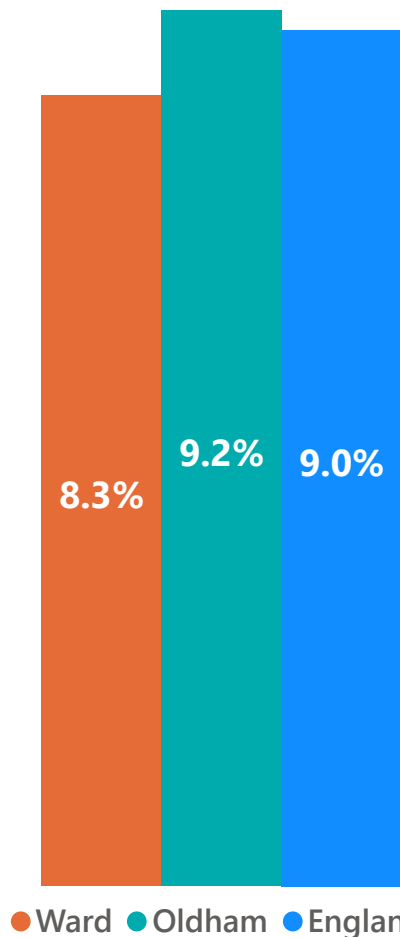

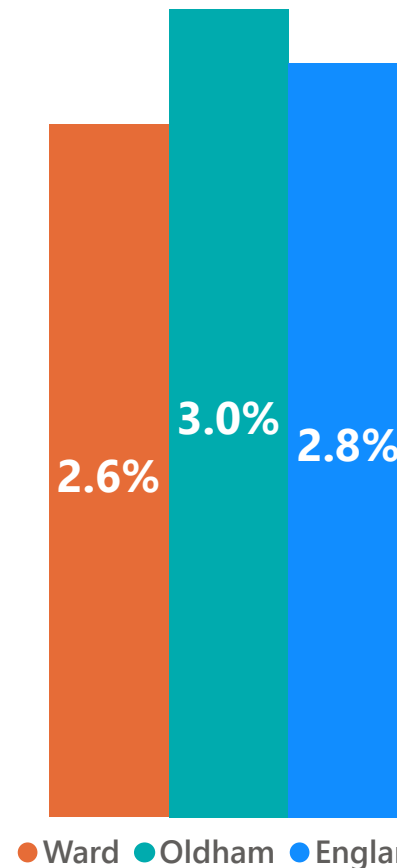

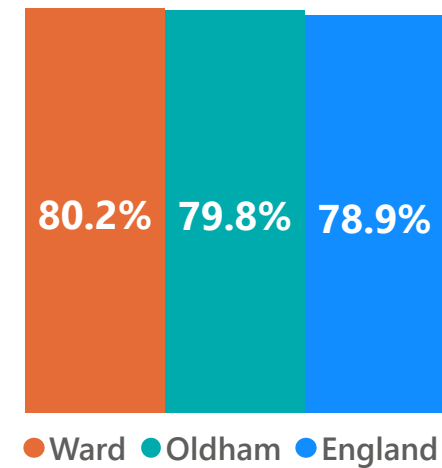

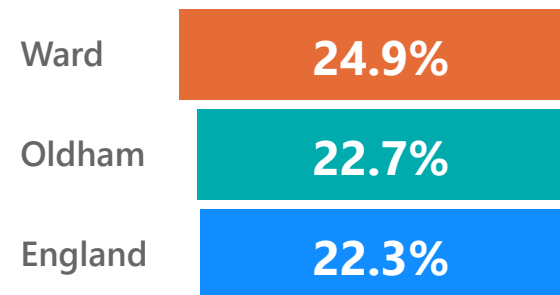


General Health 'Good' or 'Very Good'

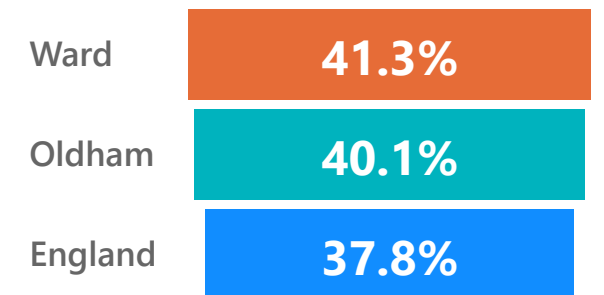
